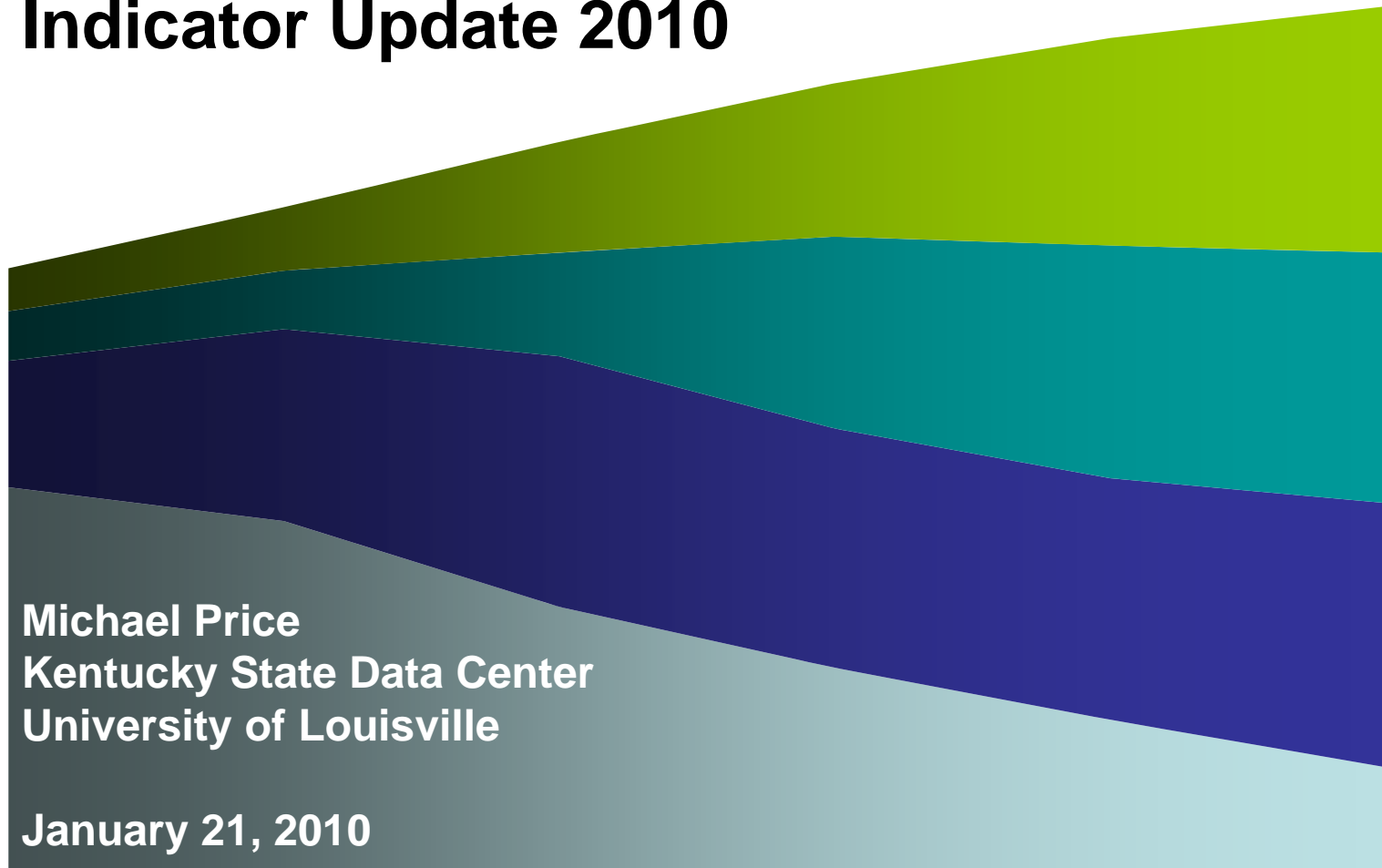
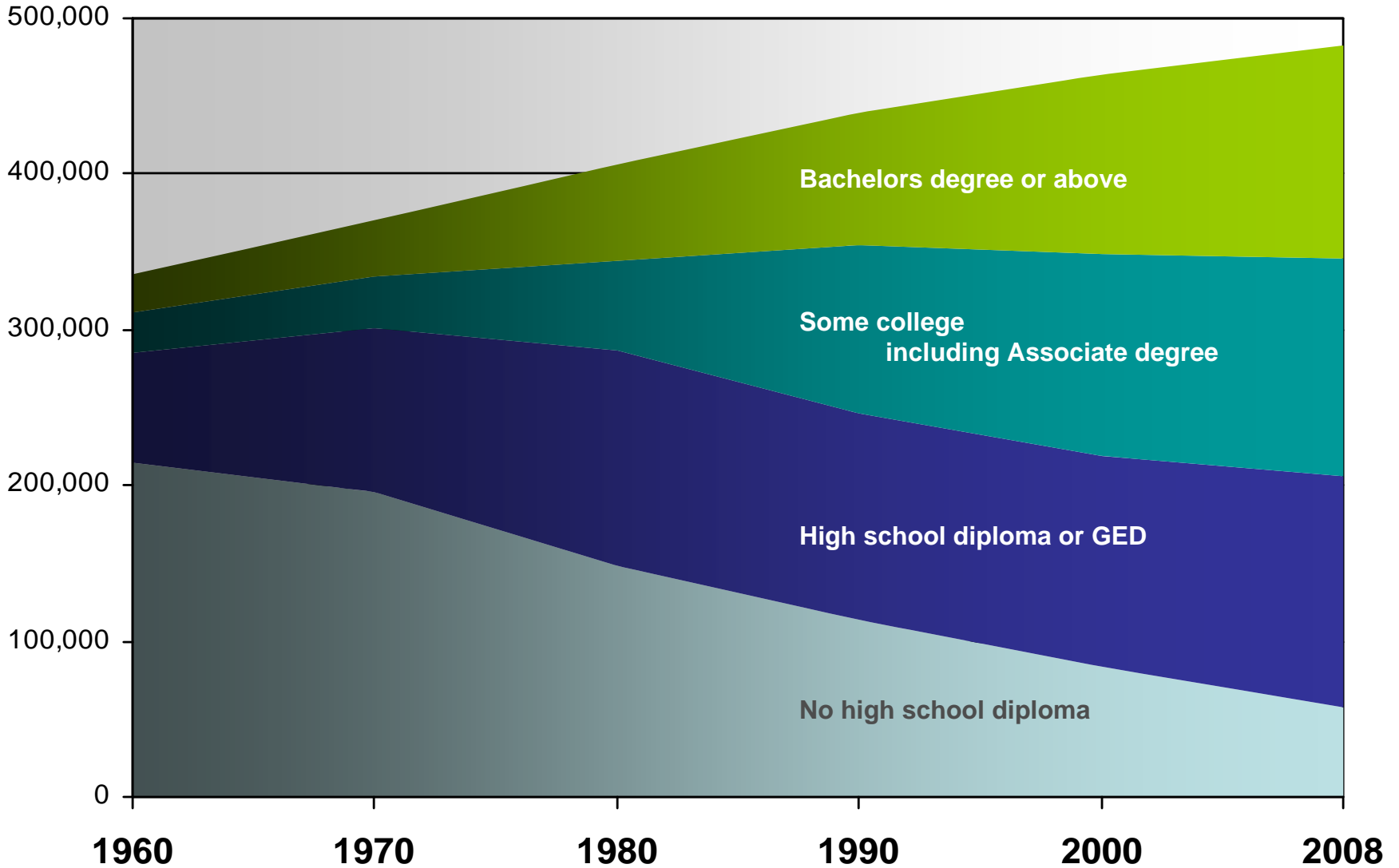

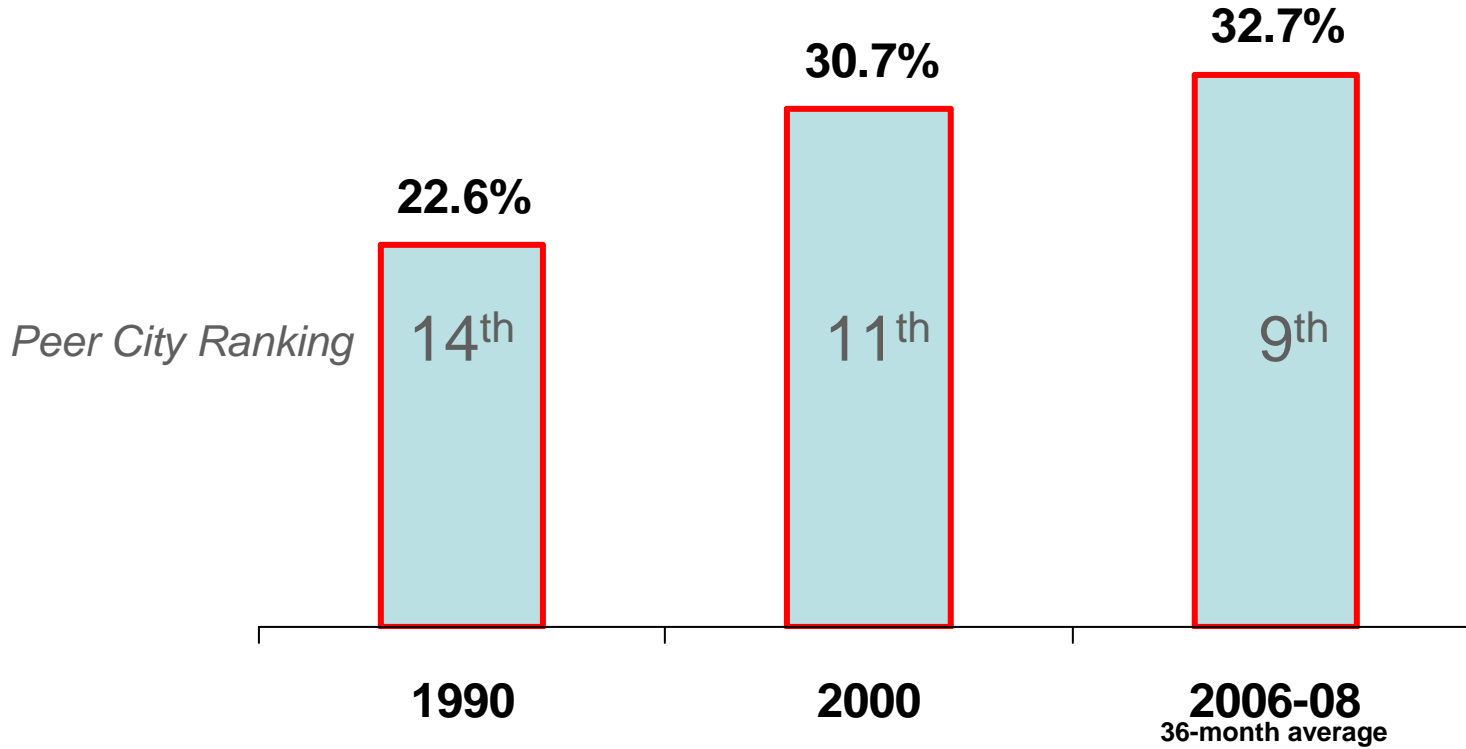

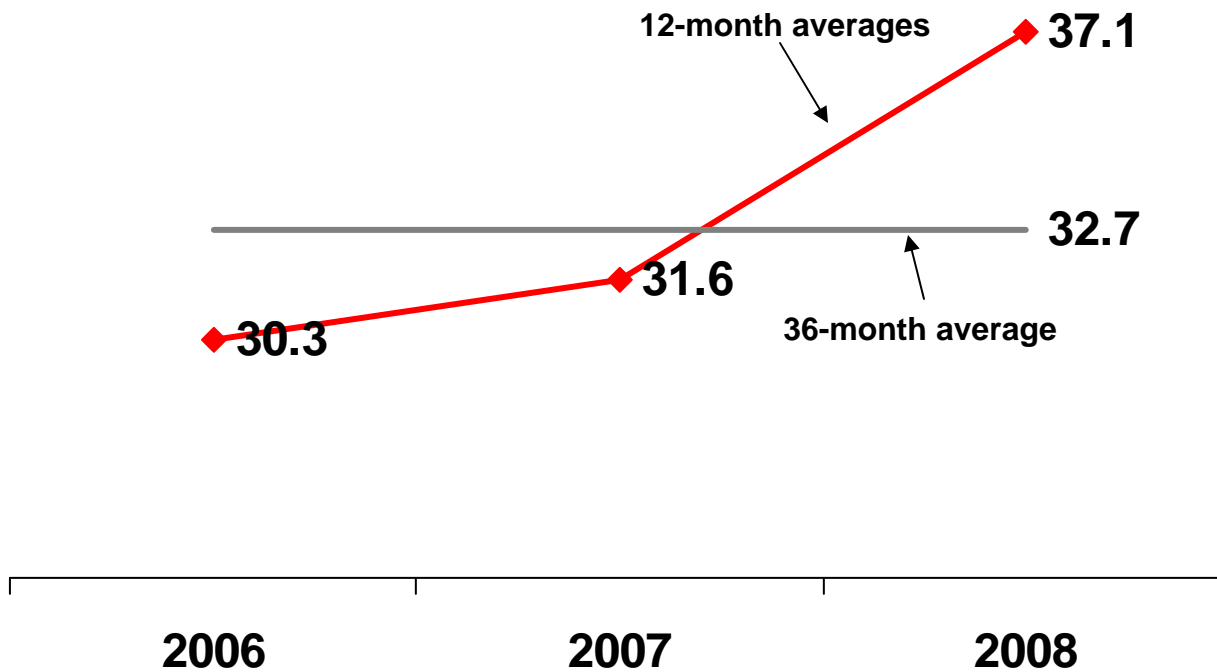

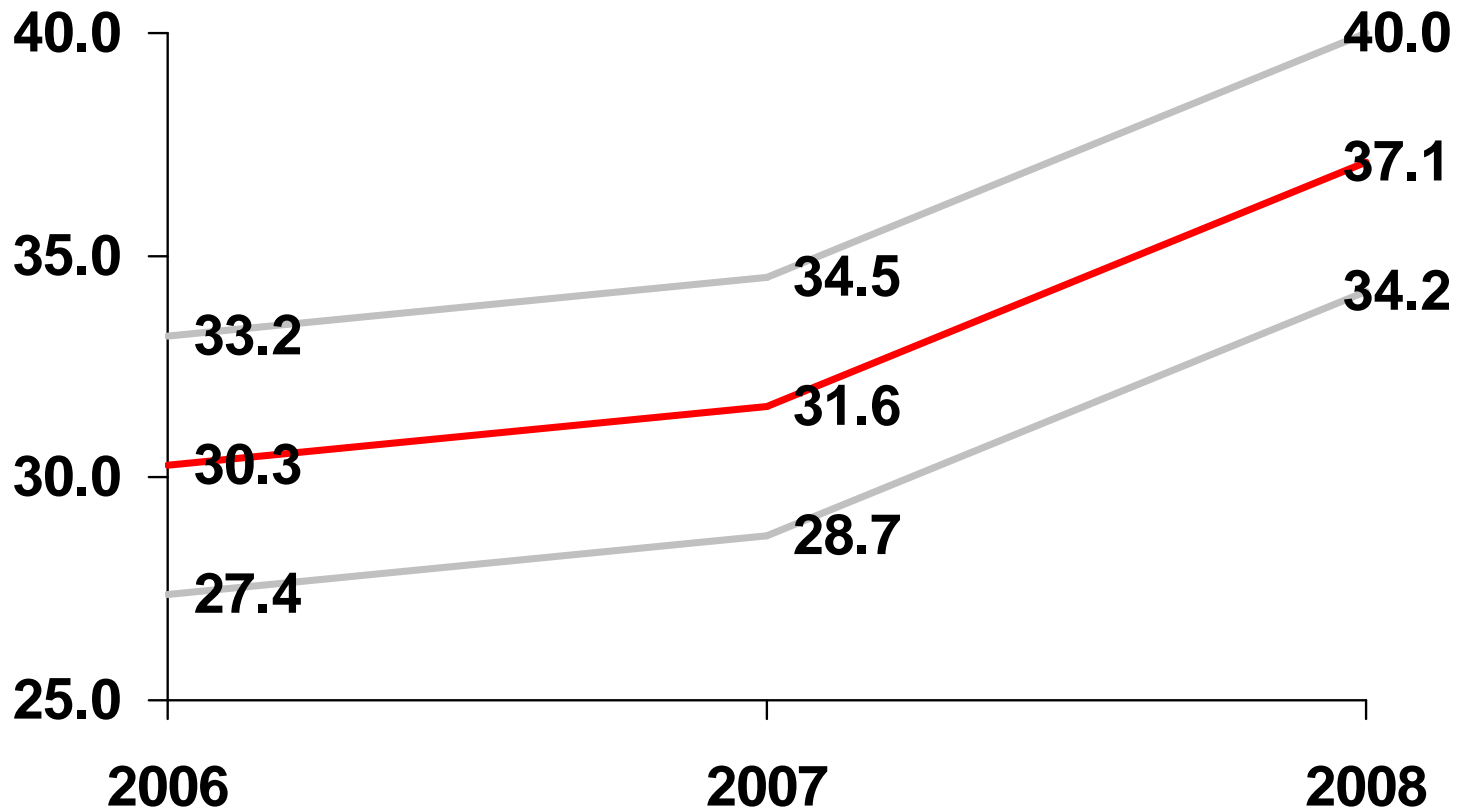
Percent persons ages 25-34 with bachelors or above Jefferson County, Kentucky

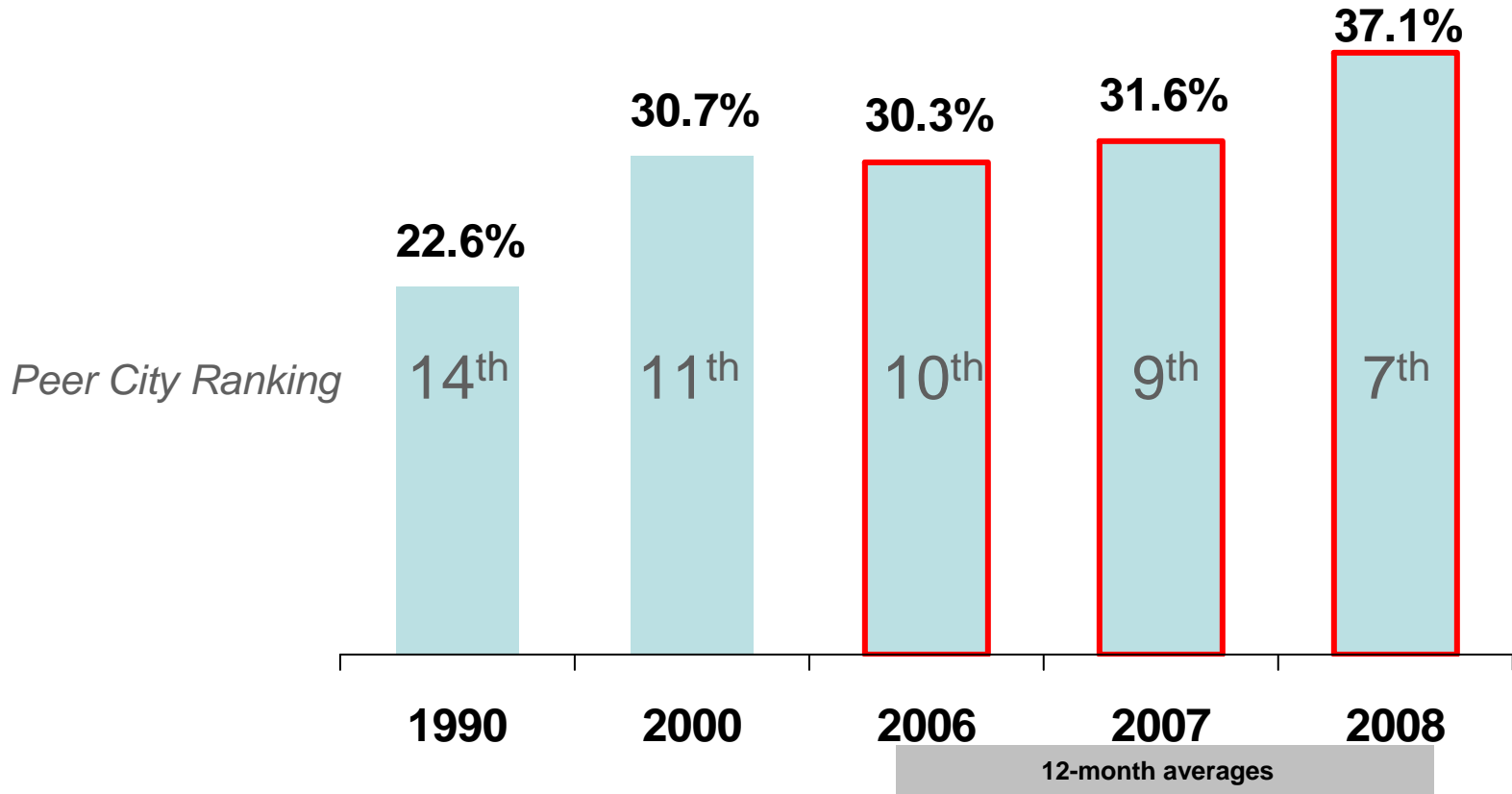
Percent persons ages 25-34 and above with bachelors or above Jefferson County, Kentucky

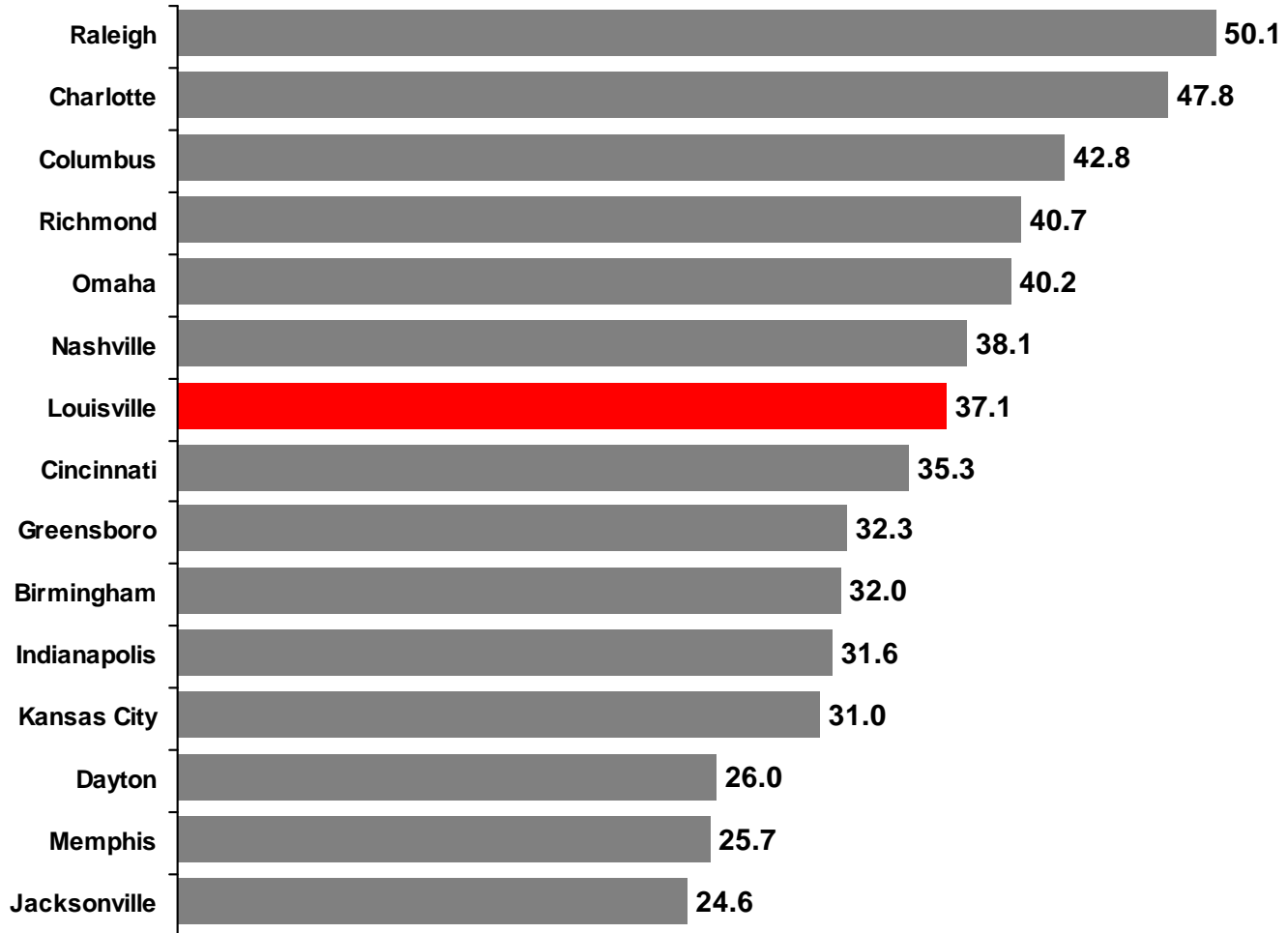

Percent Persons Ages 25-34 with Bachelors Degree or Above

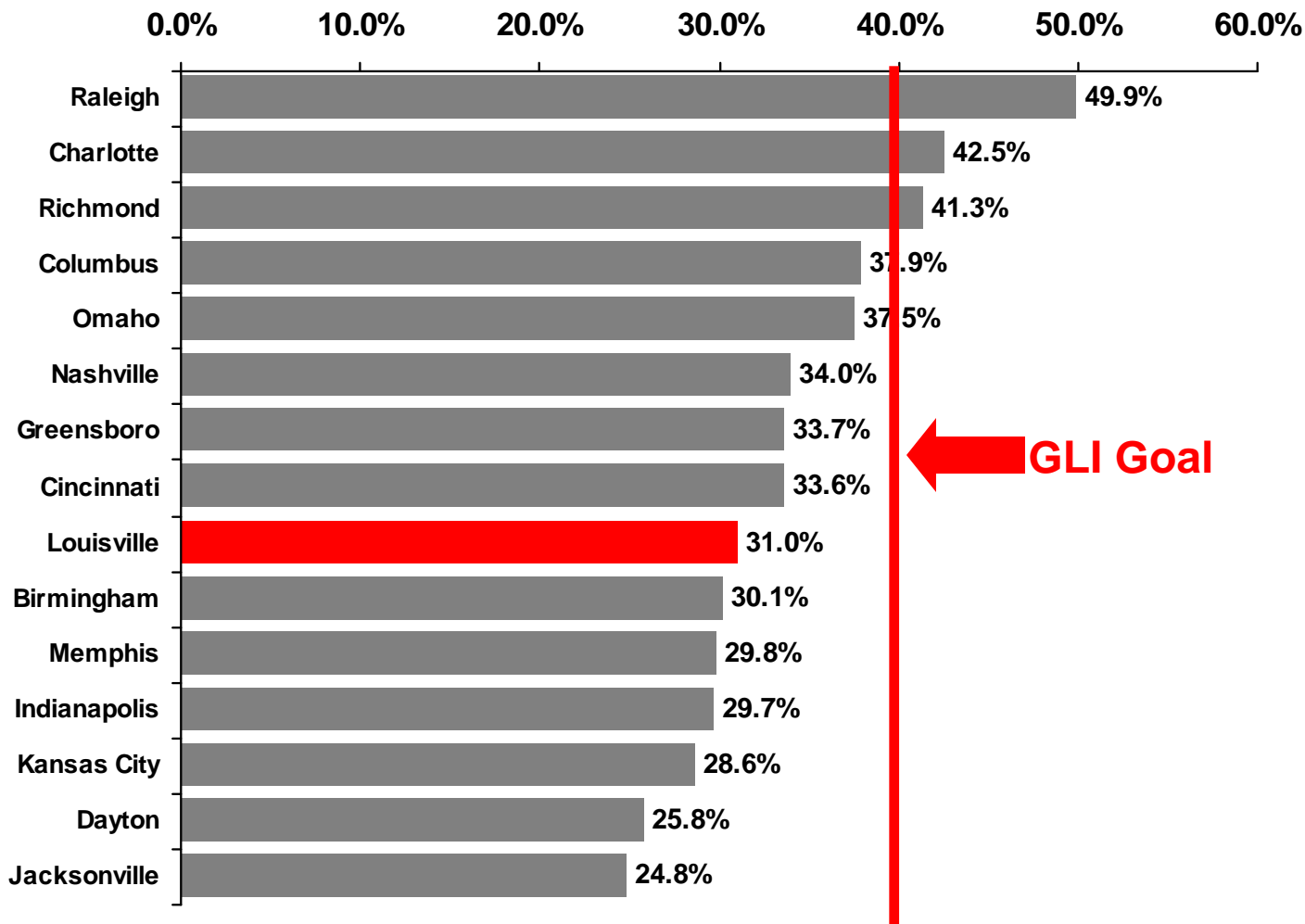

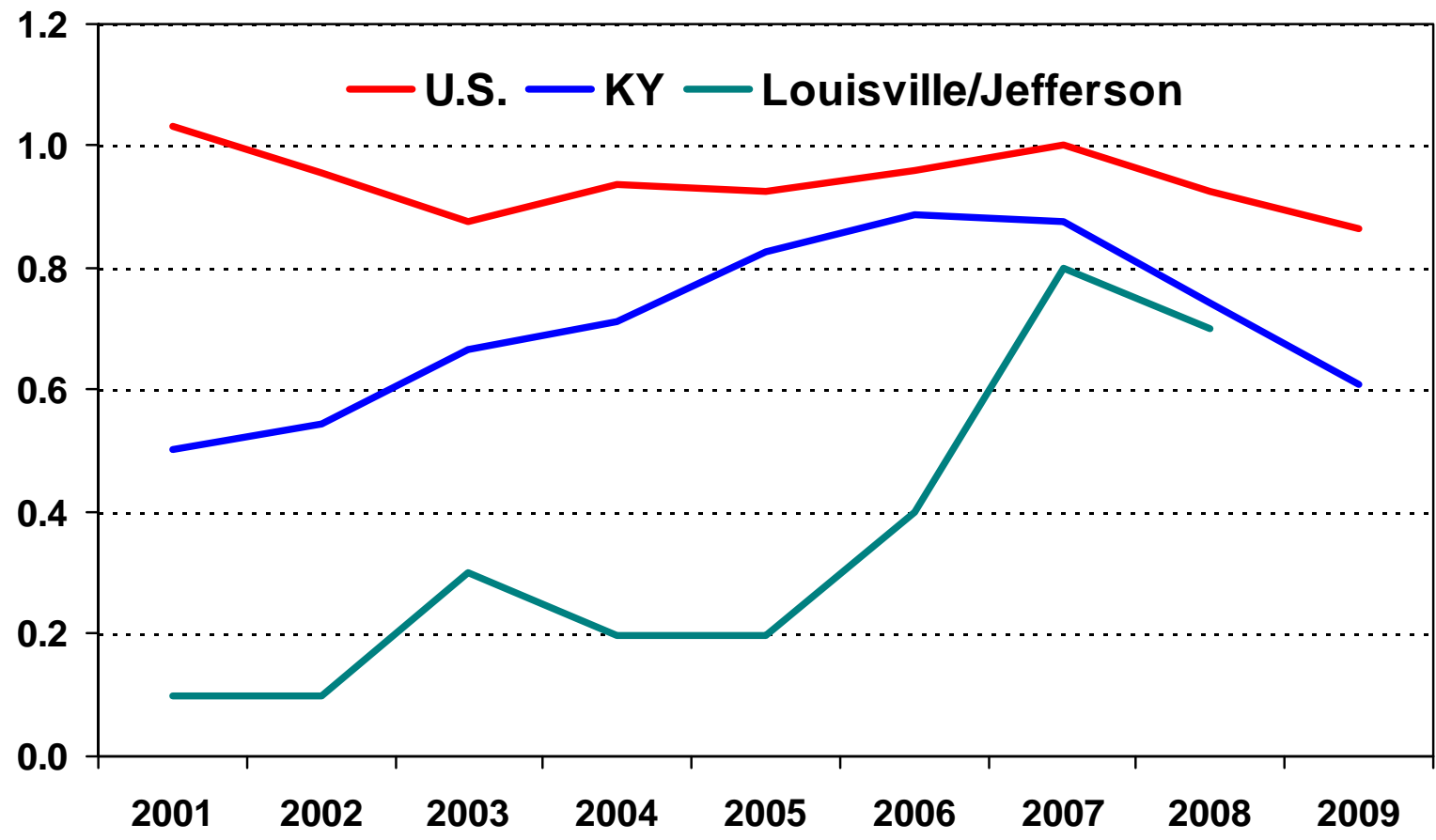

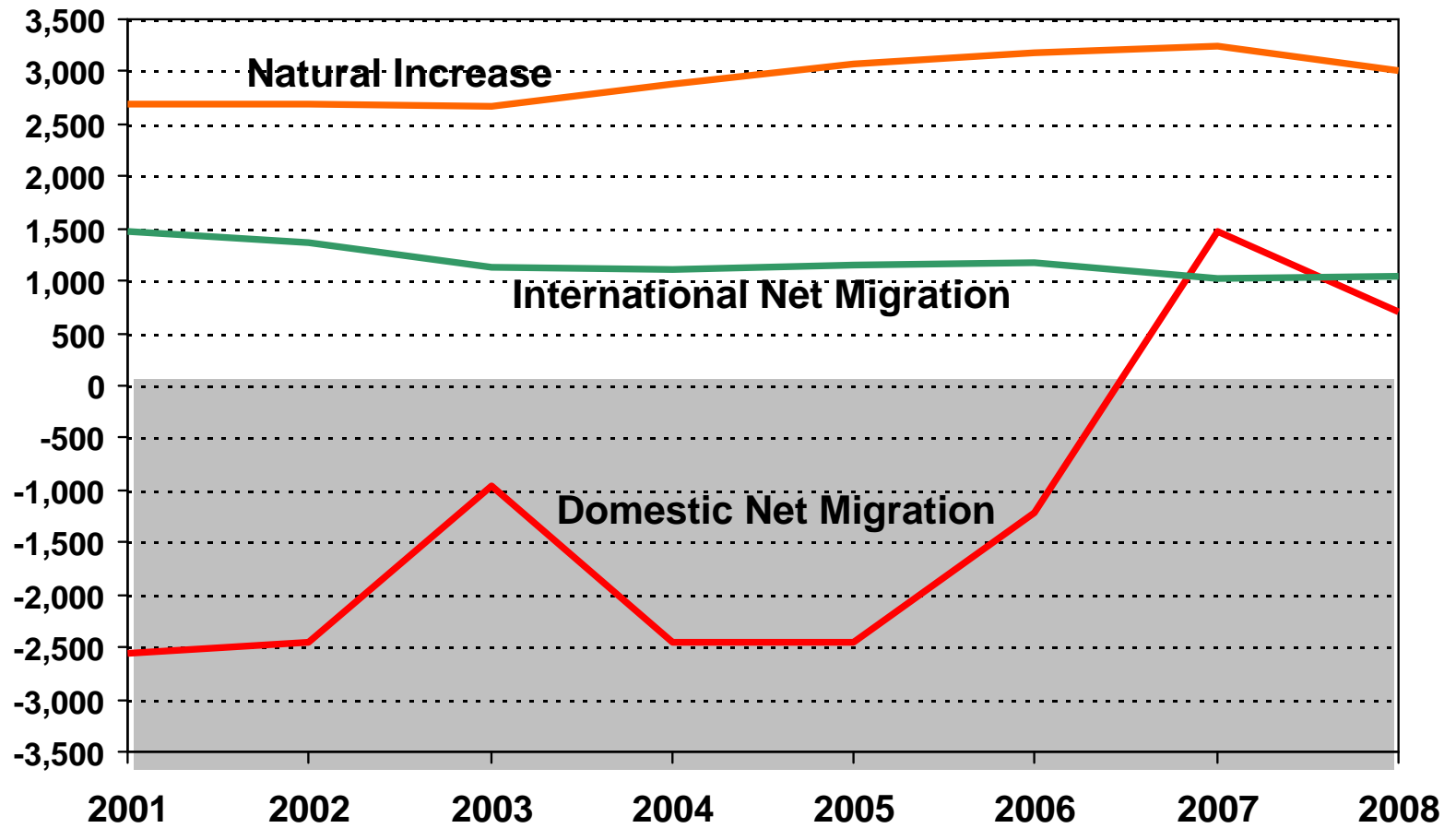

Annual Rates of Population Growth

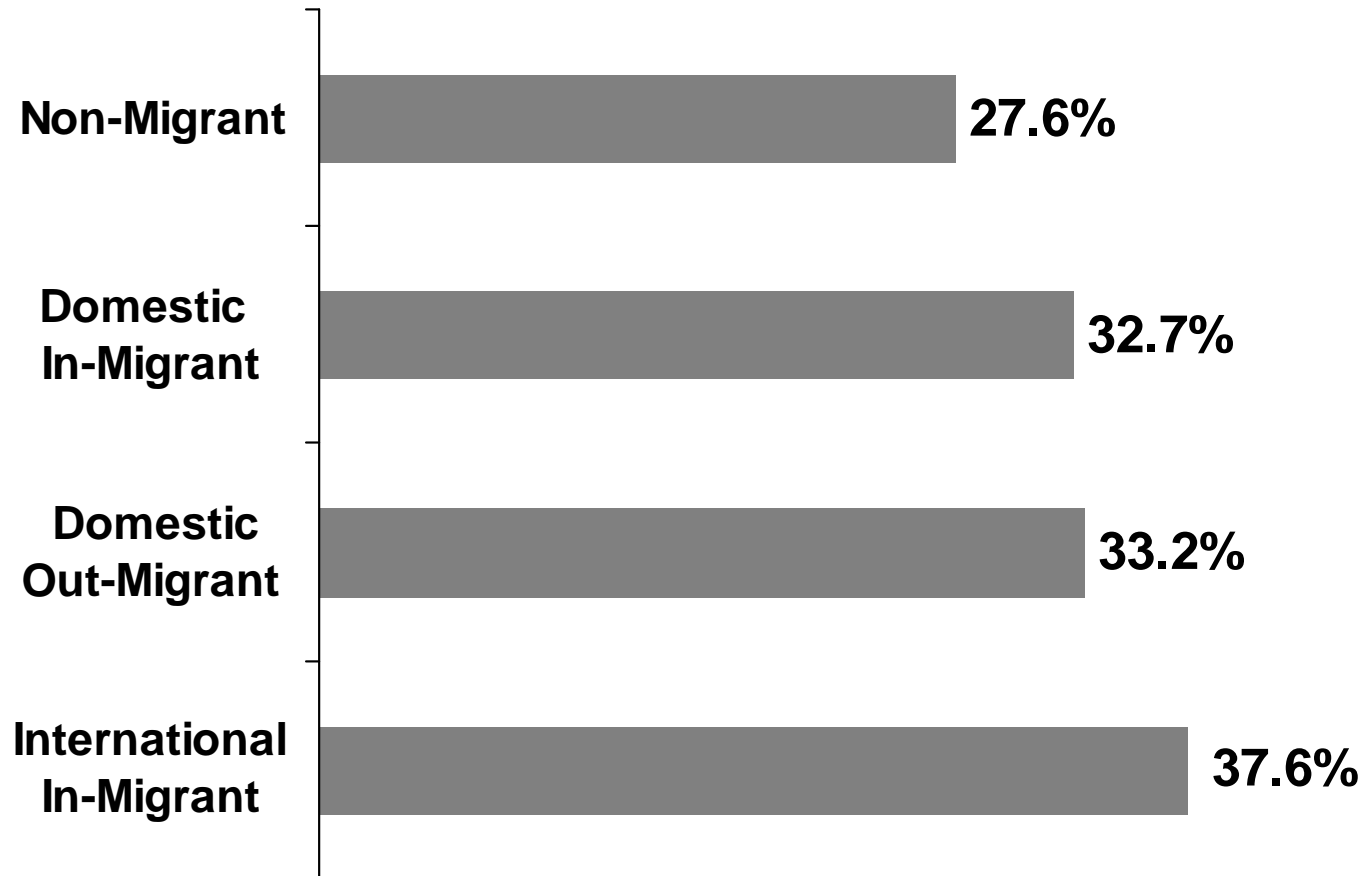

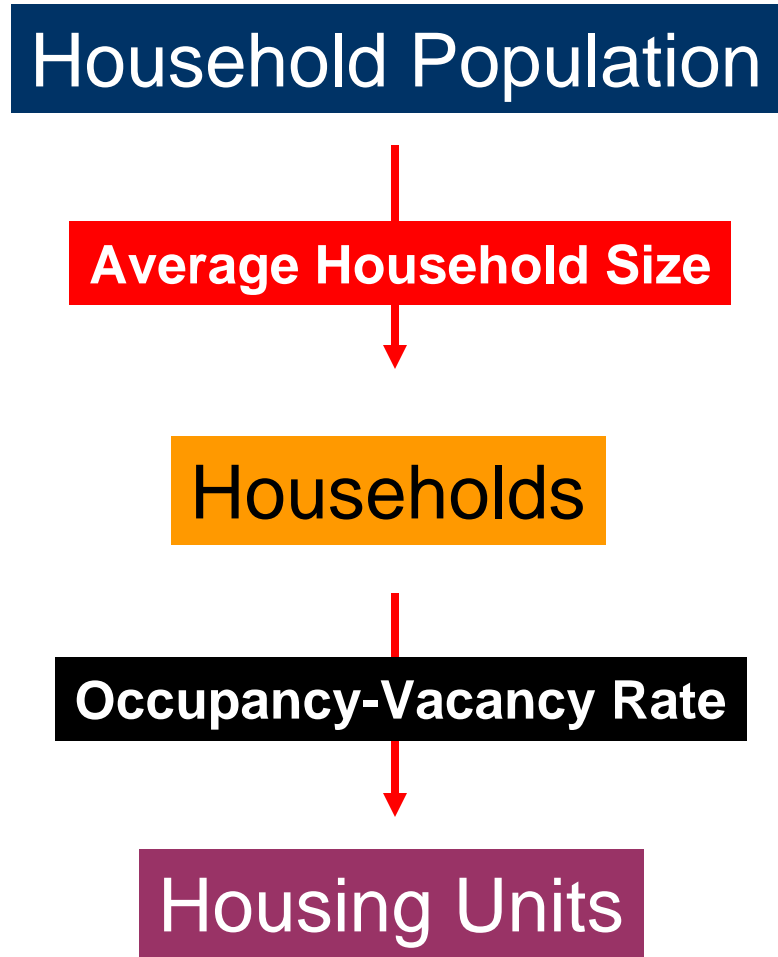

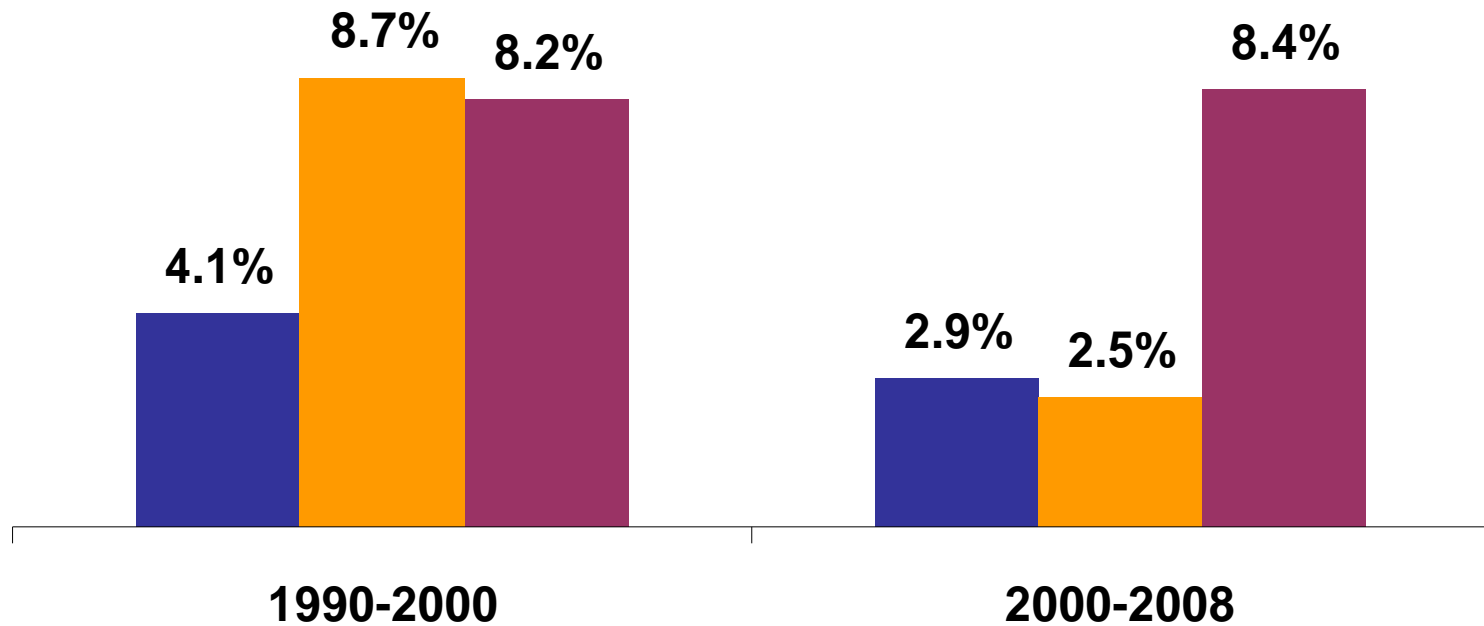

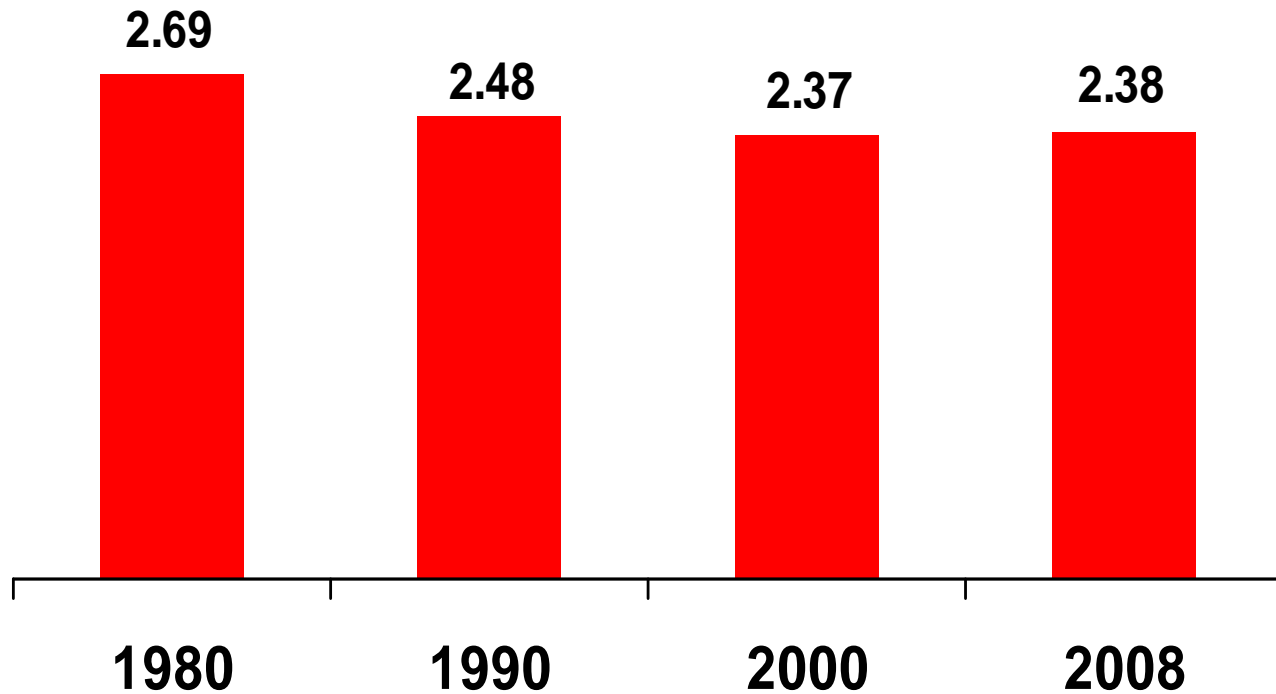

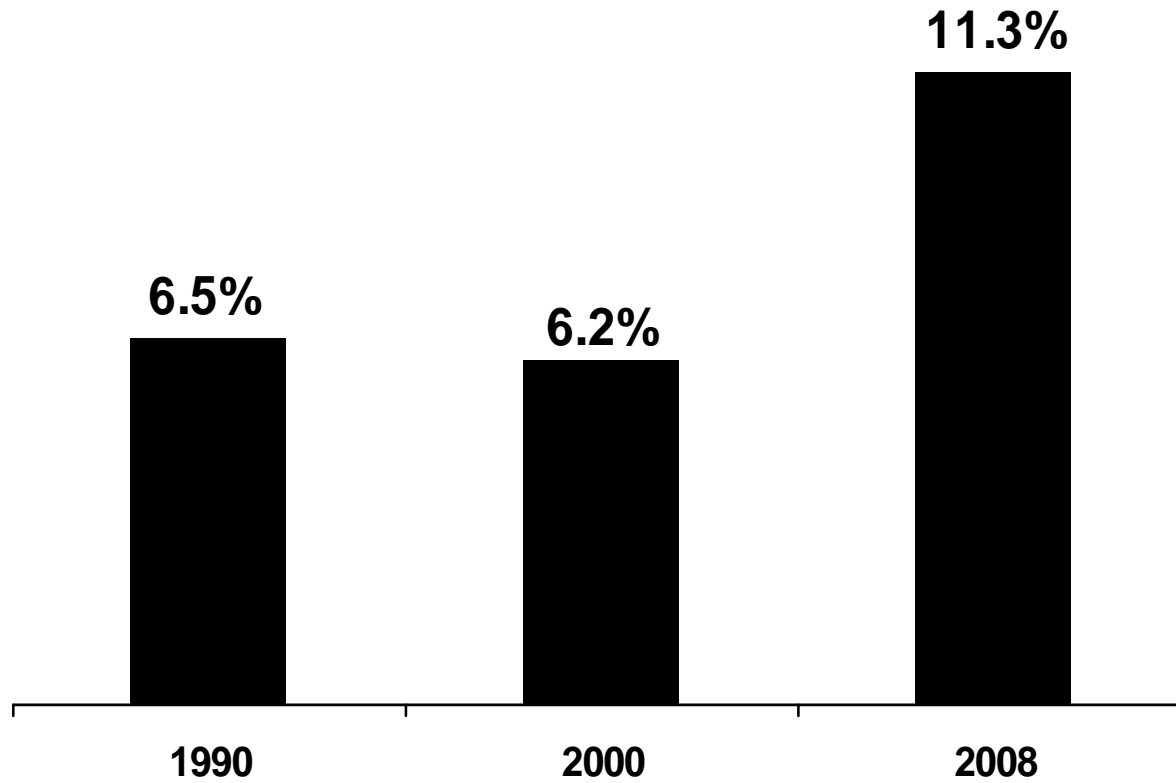
Jefferson County Average Household Size

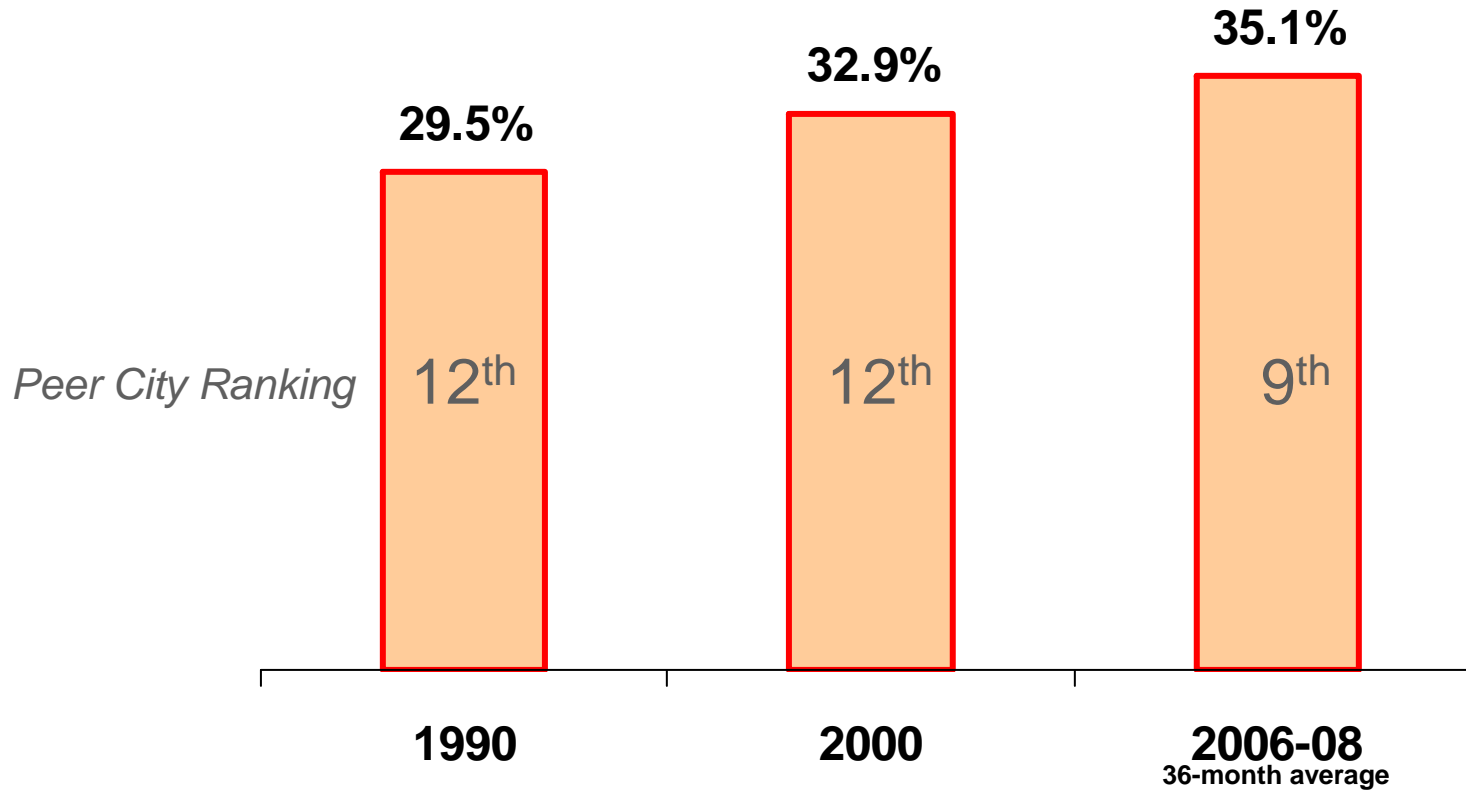


Jefferson County Vacancy Rates

Percent Housing Units Vacant

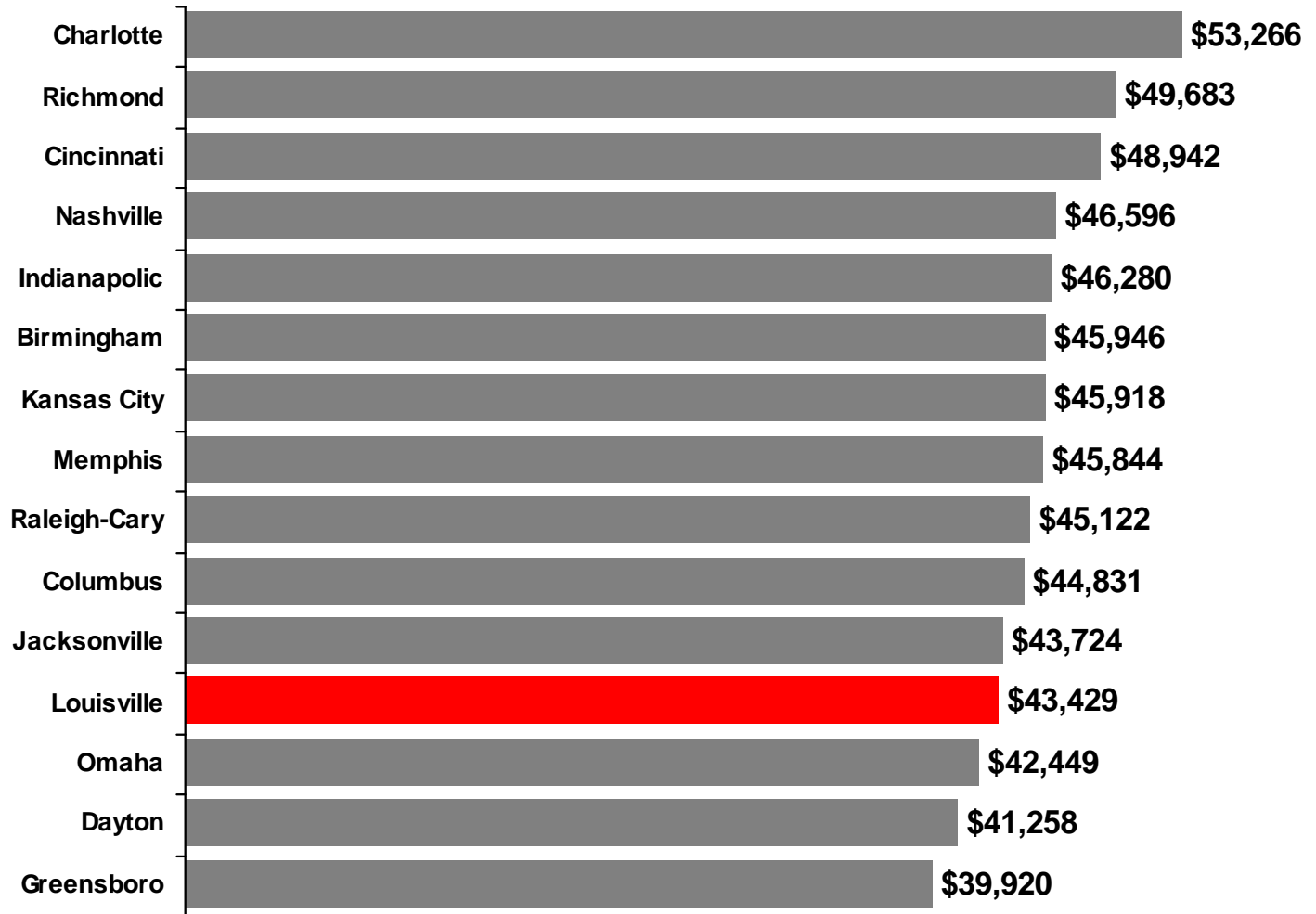


Percent employed persons in professional/technical jobs Jefferson County, Kentucky

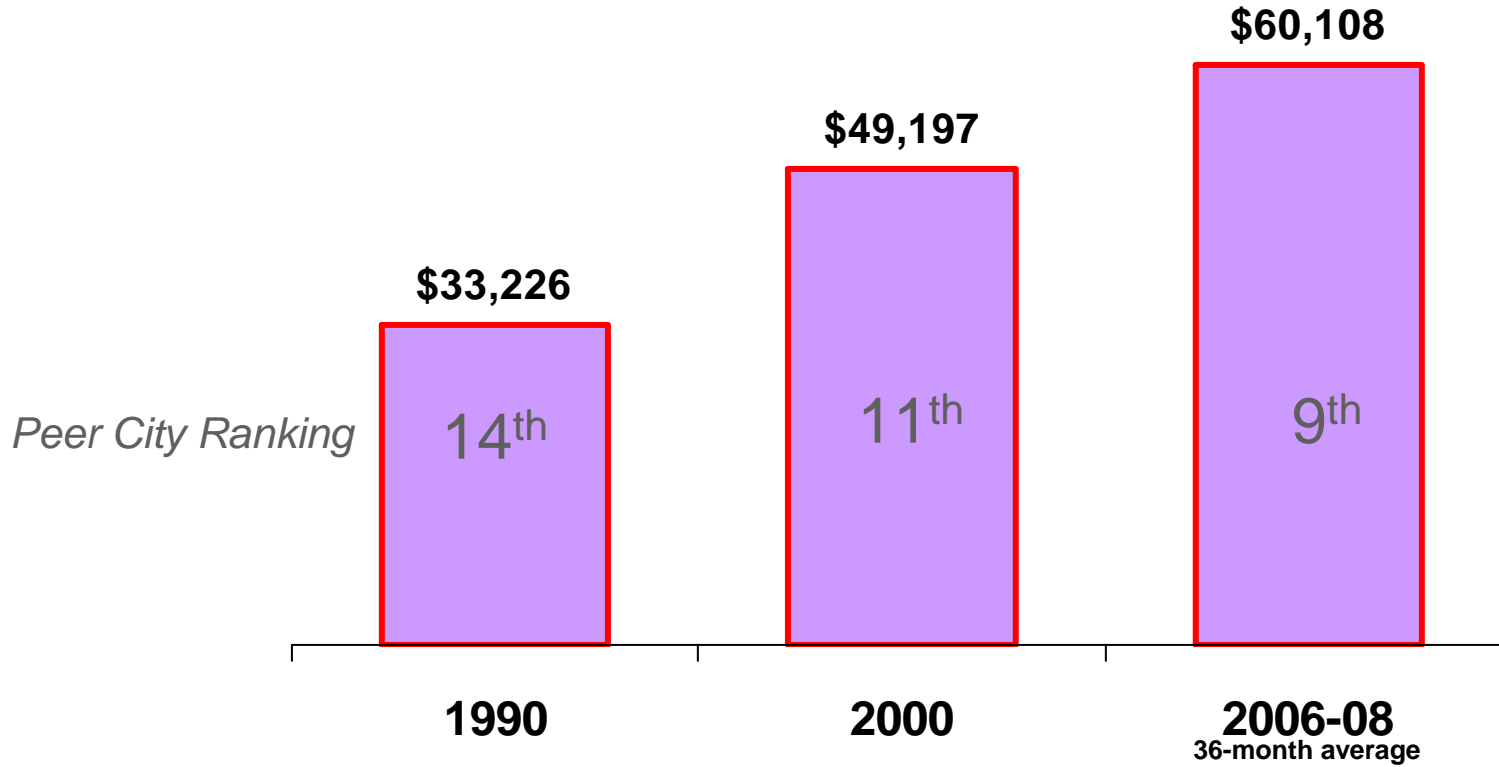
Average Annual Wages 2008

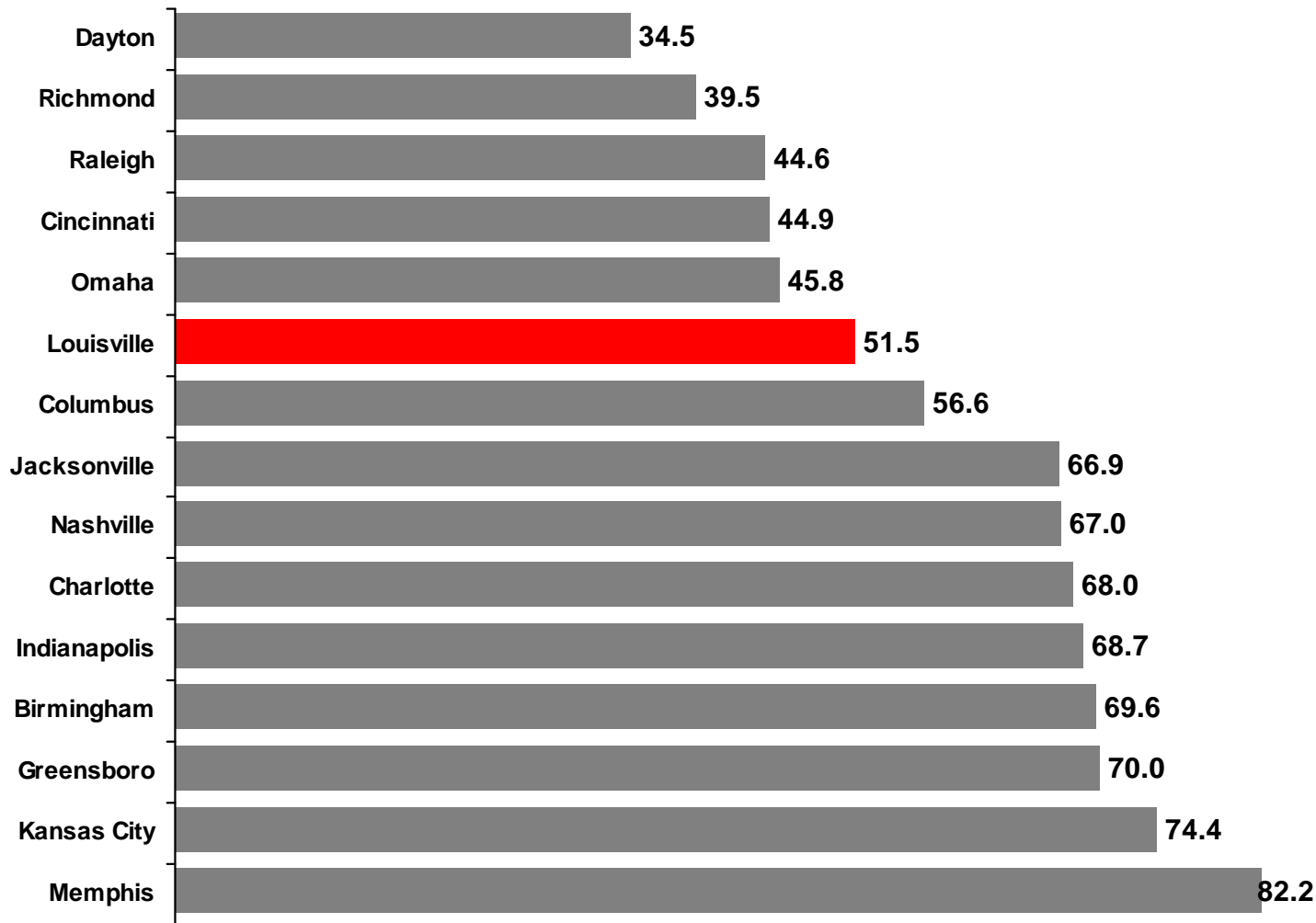
Median Family Income Jefferson County, Kentucky

Number of crime reports per 1,000 persons

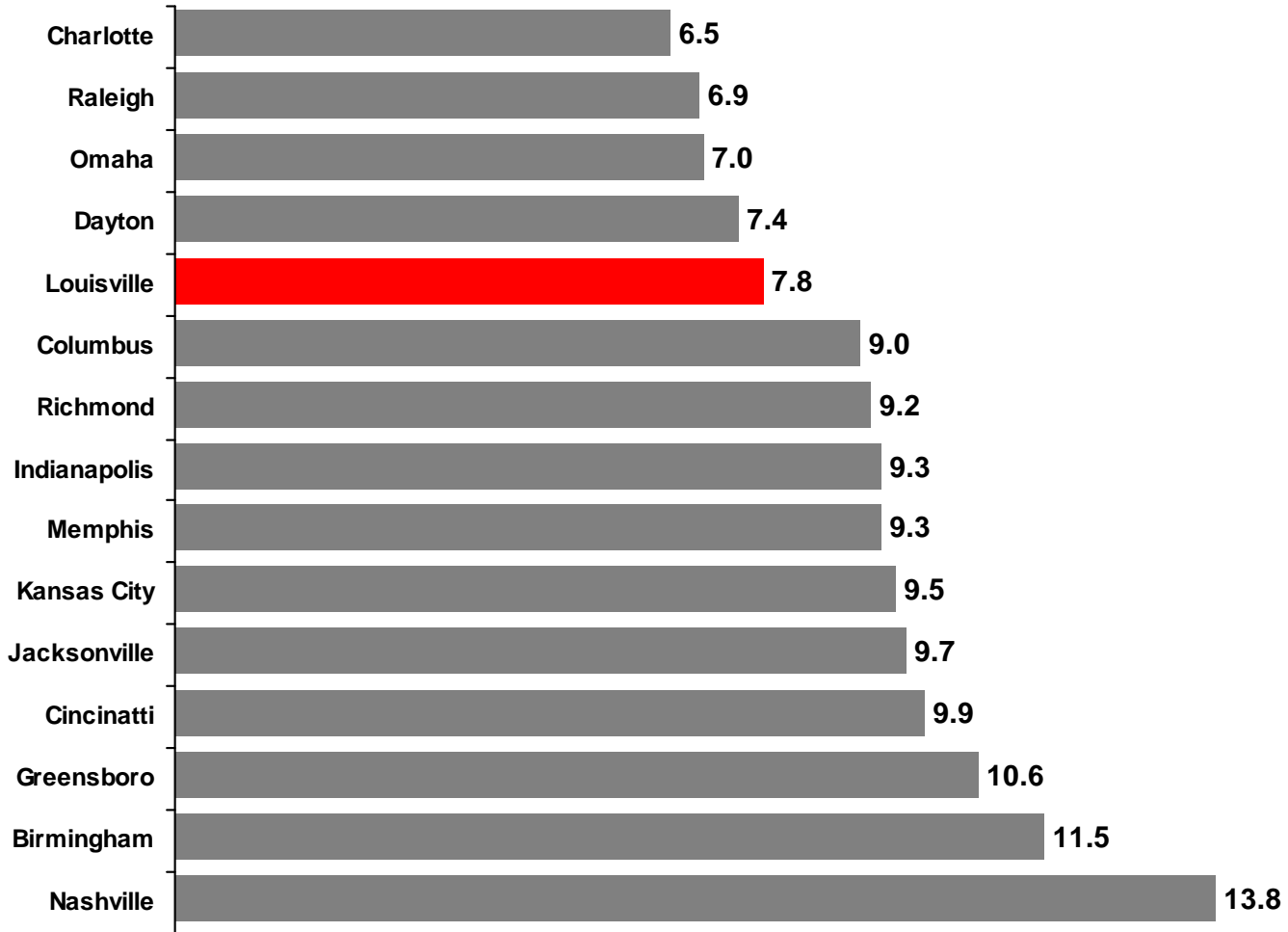

Infant Mortality 2006

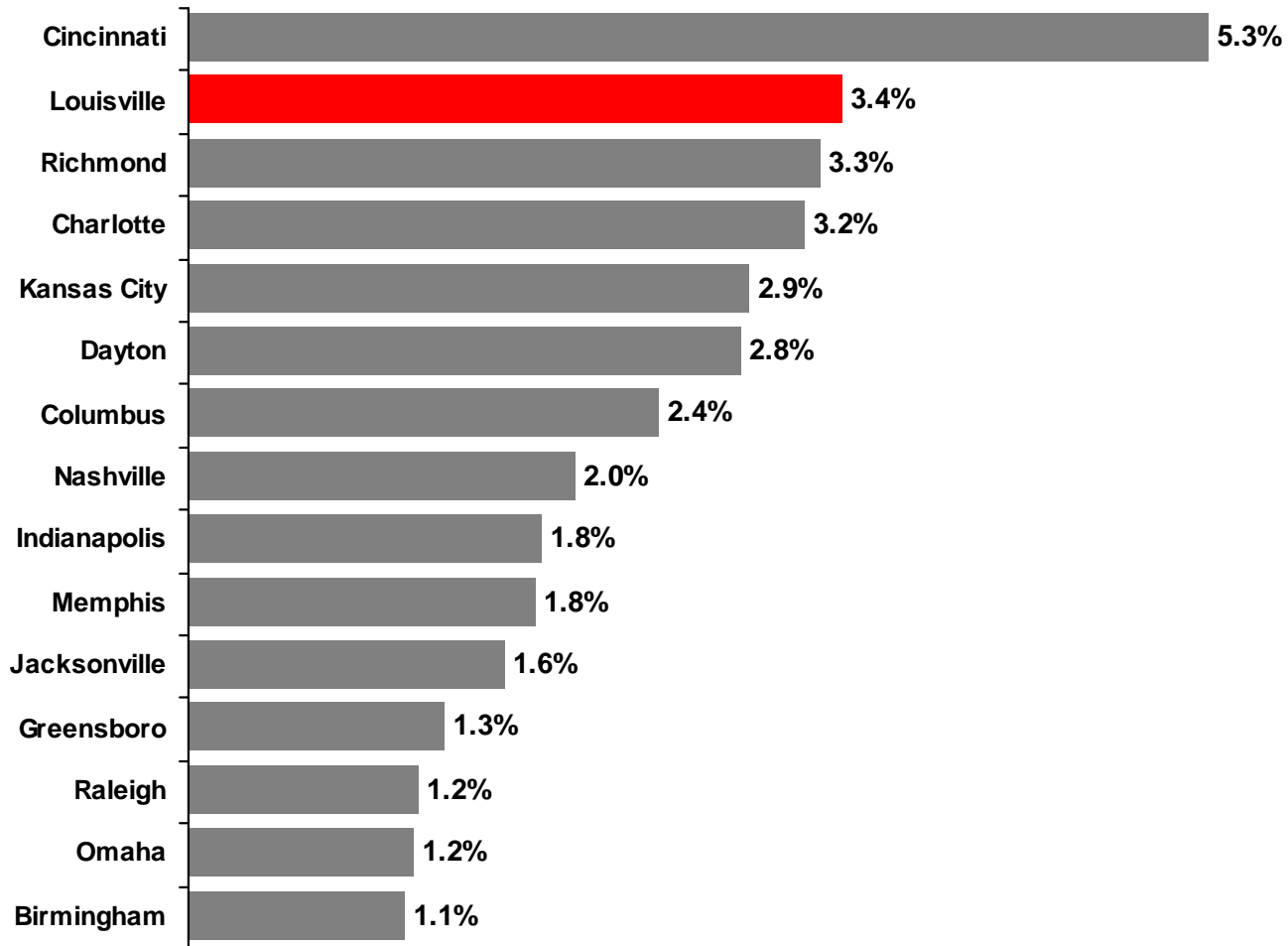
Deaths under age 1 per 1,000 live births

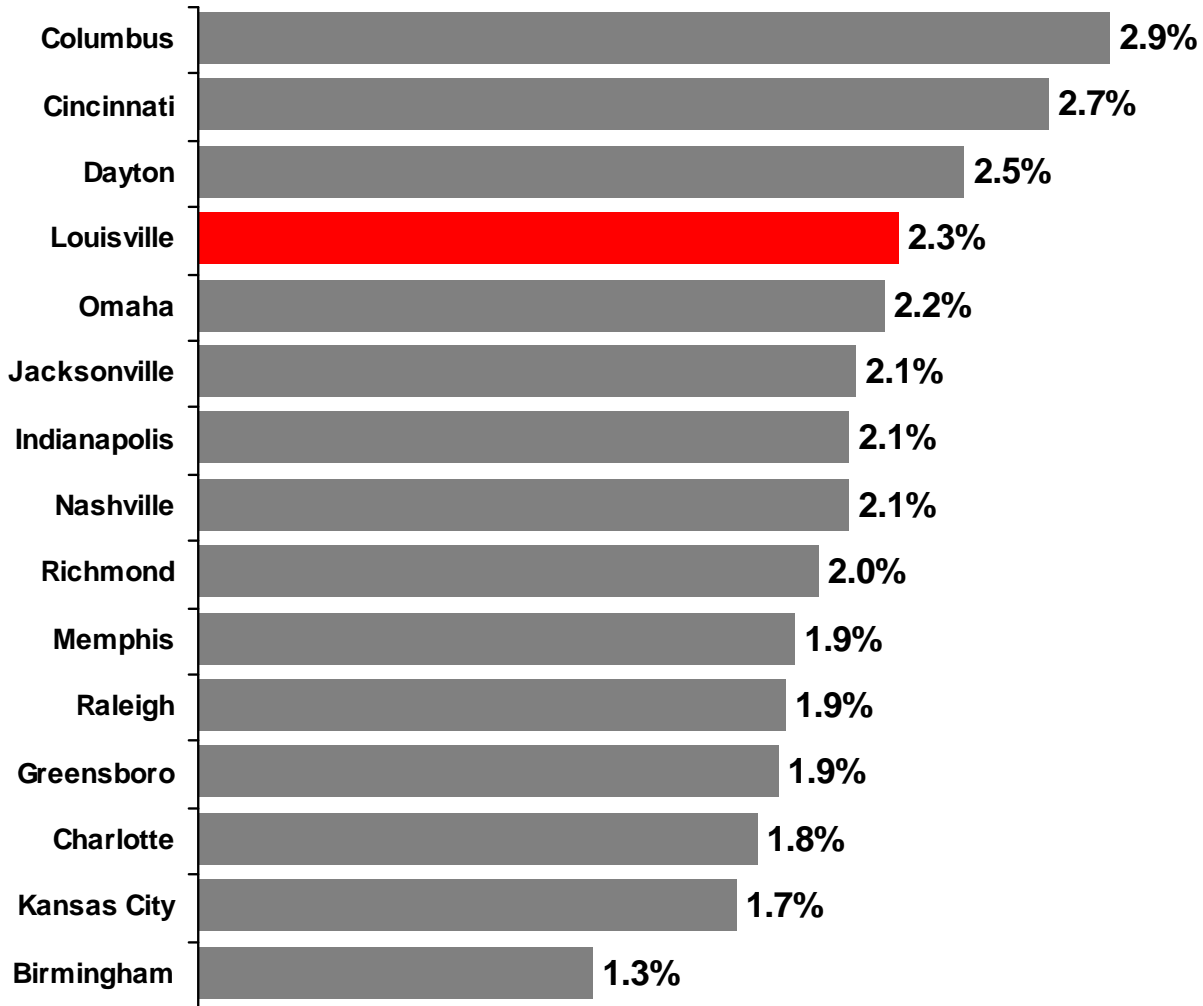
Percent Workers Using Public Transportation

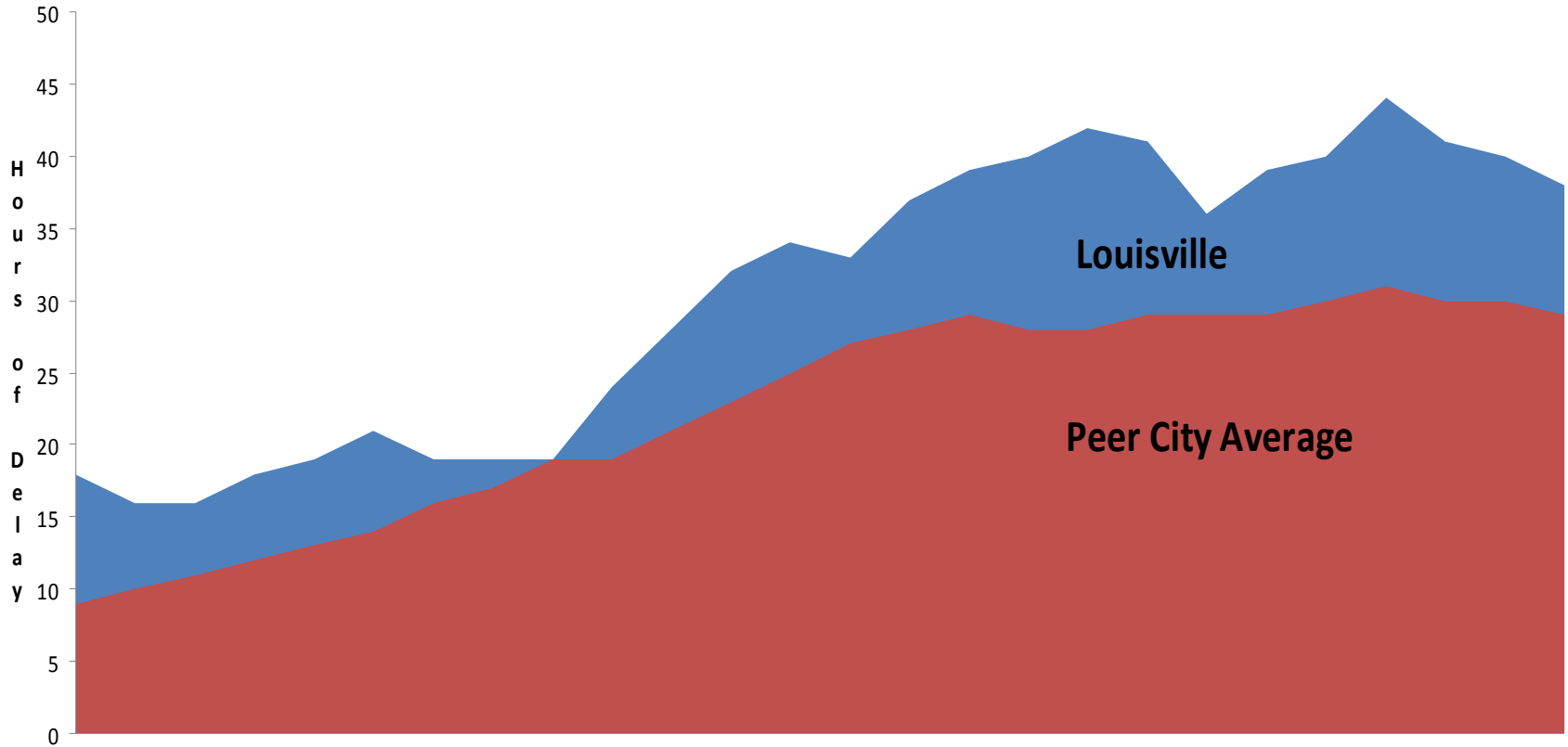
Percent Workers Who Walked or Biked



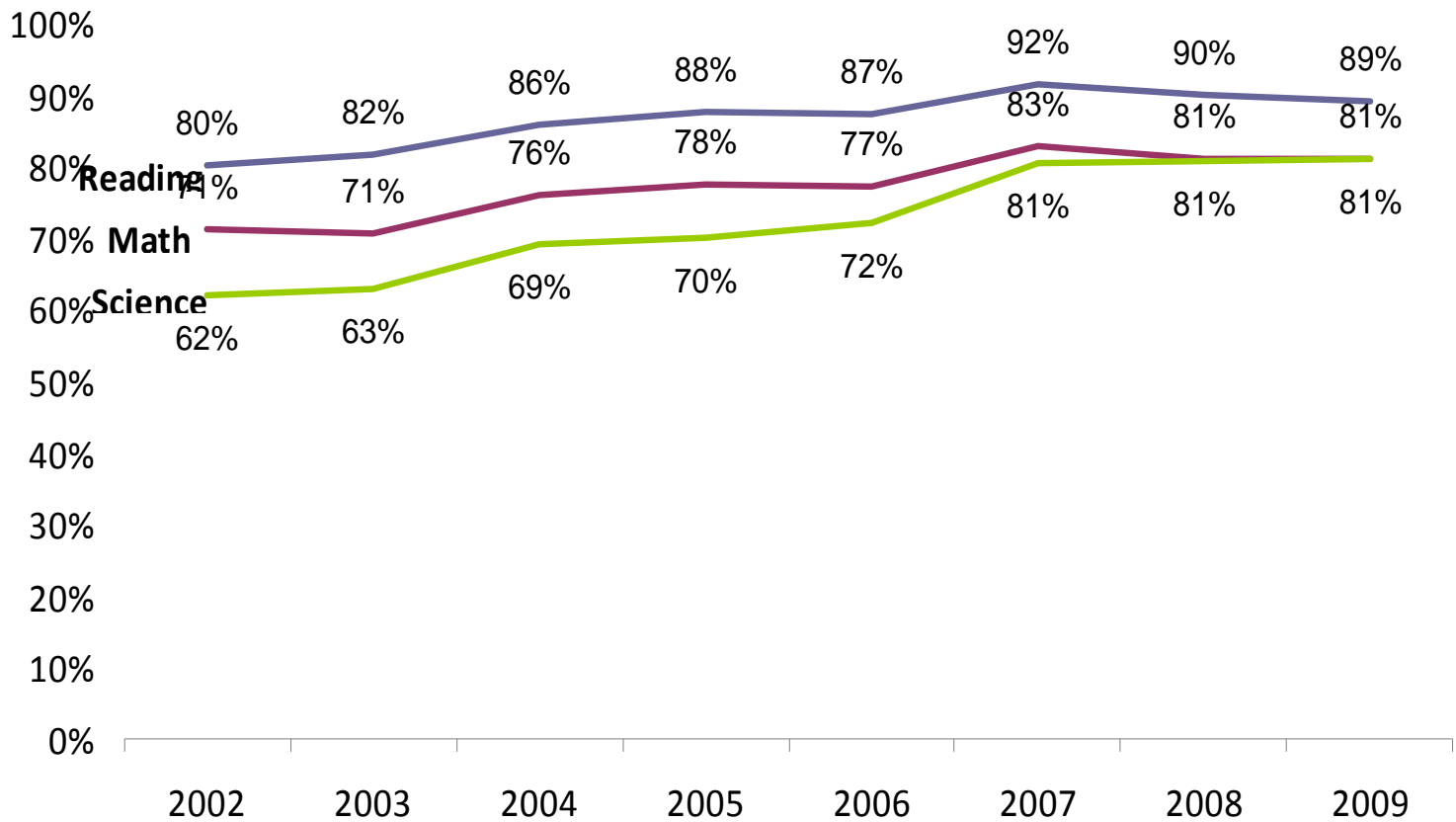
