

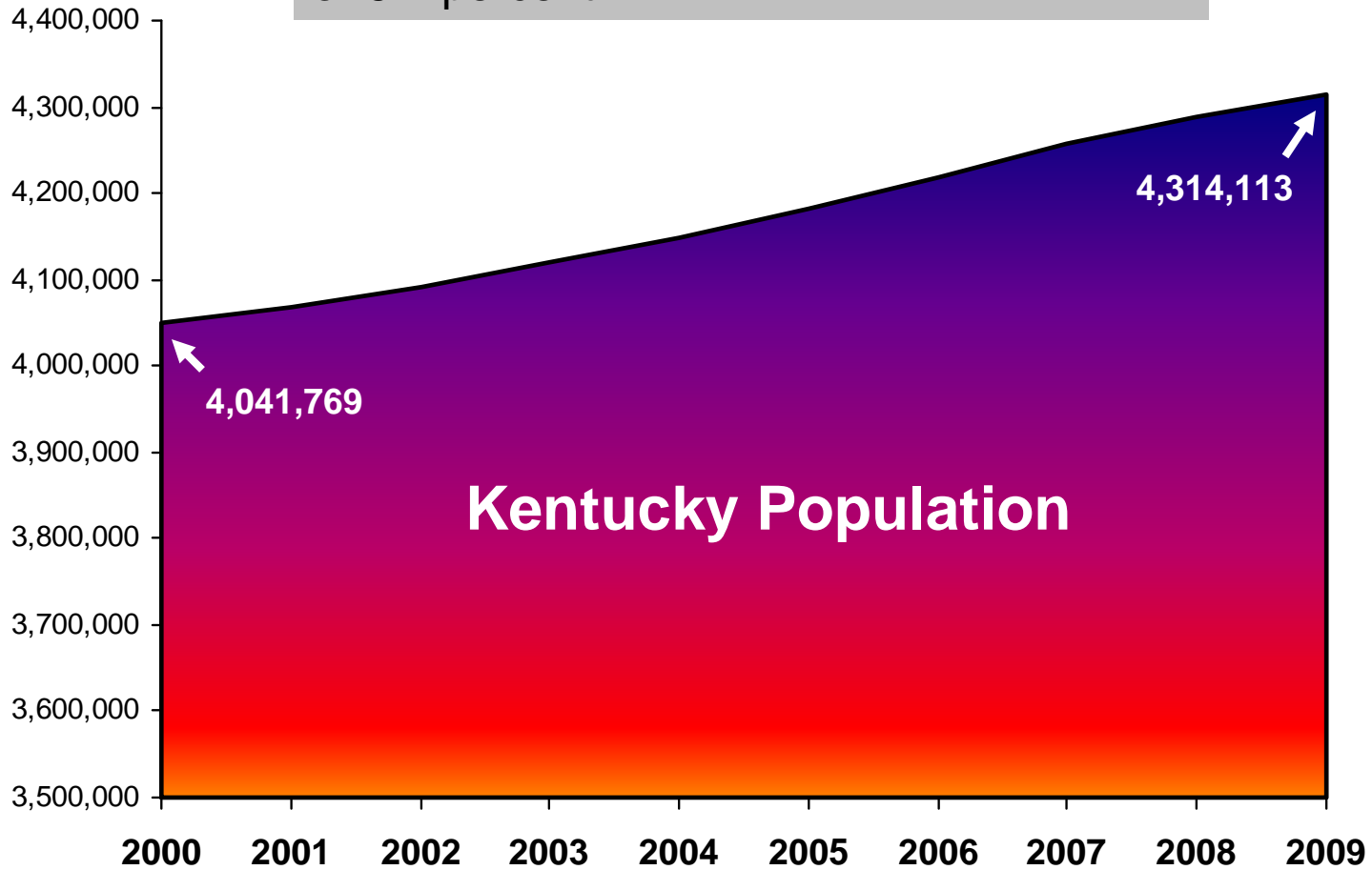

From the 2000 Census to July 1, 2009, the state population grew by 272,000 persons or 6.7 percent.

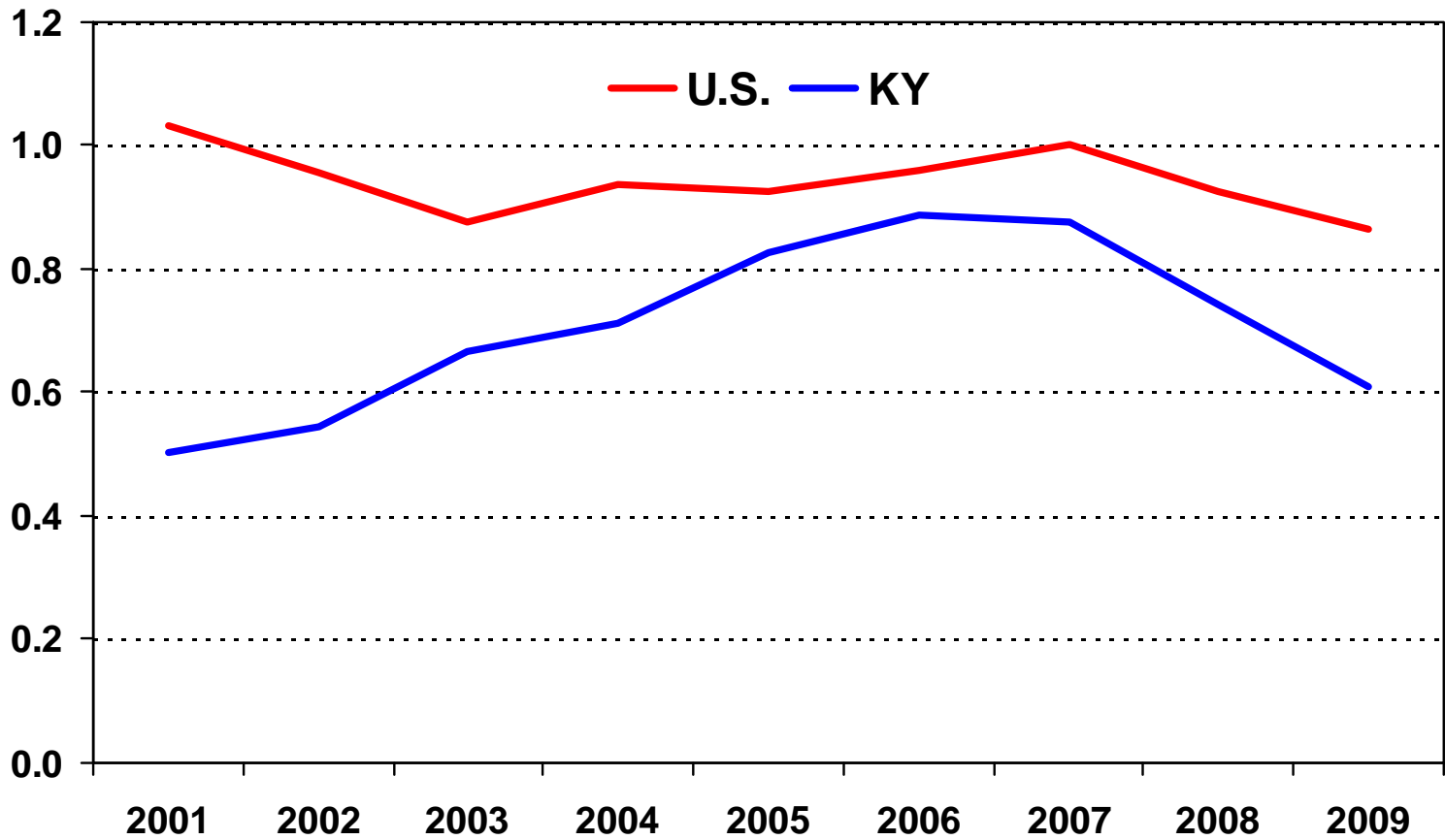
Compared to all other states and D.C.

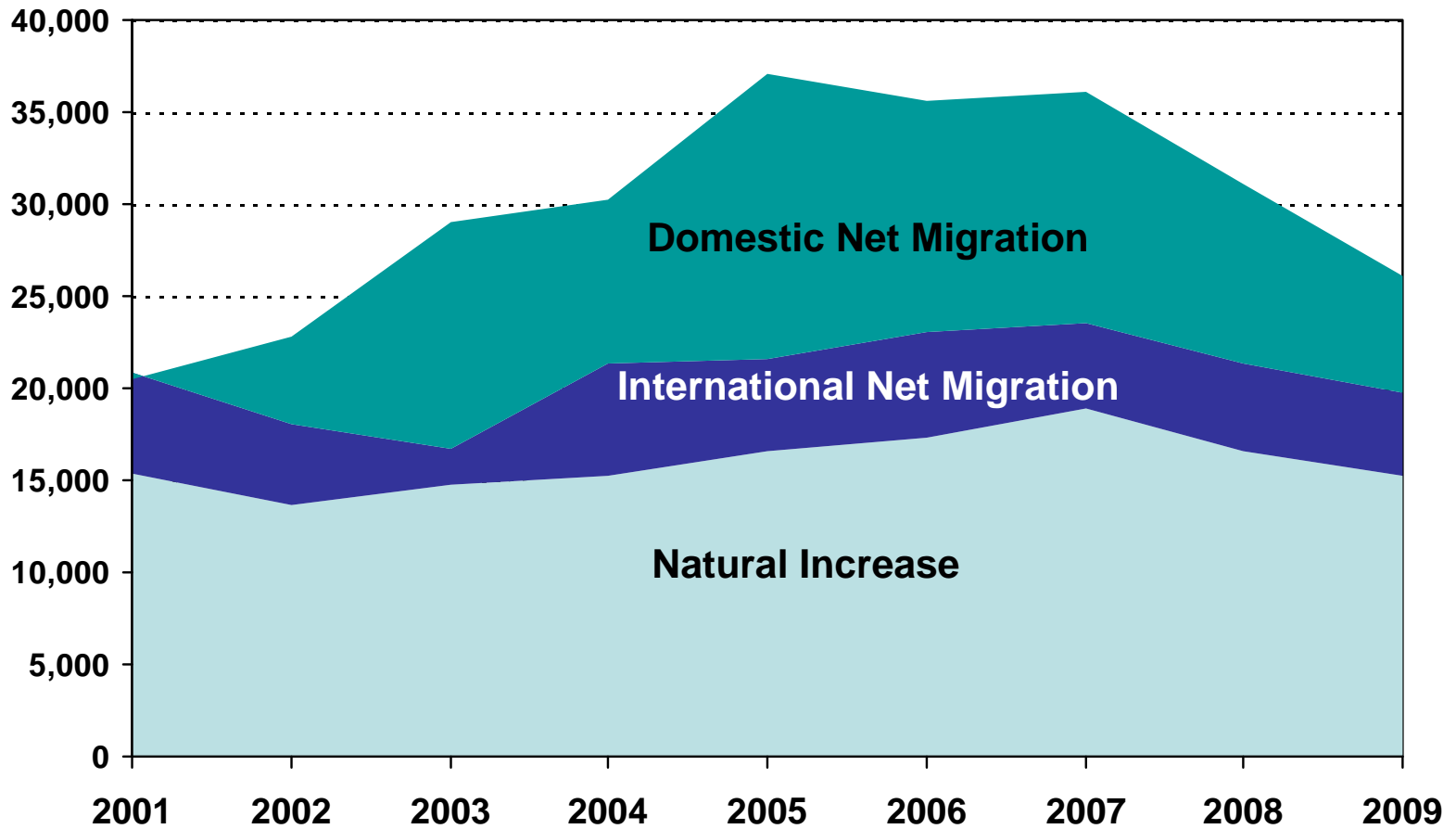

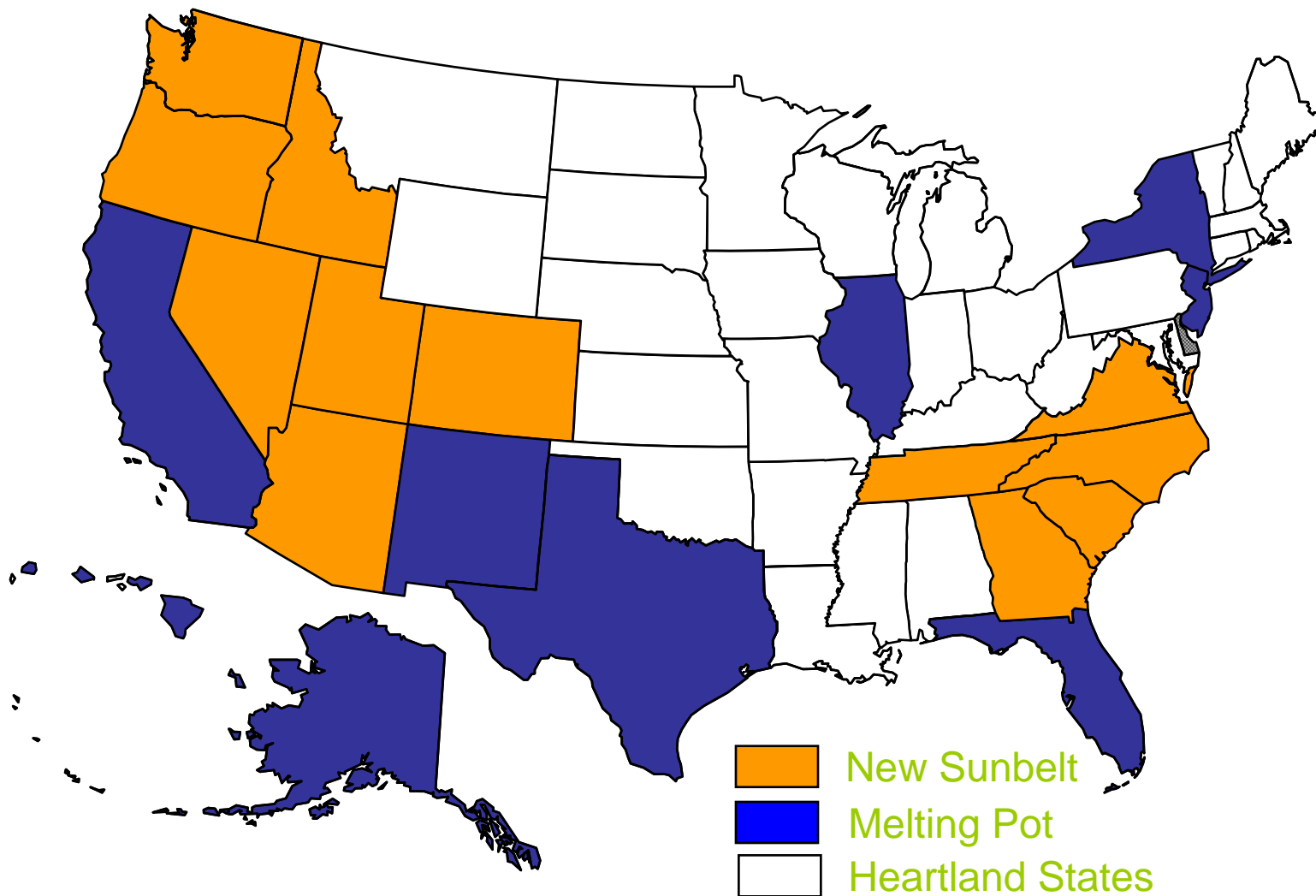

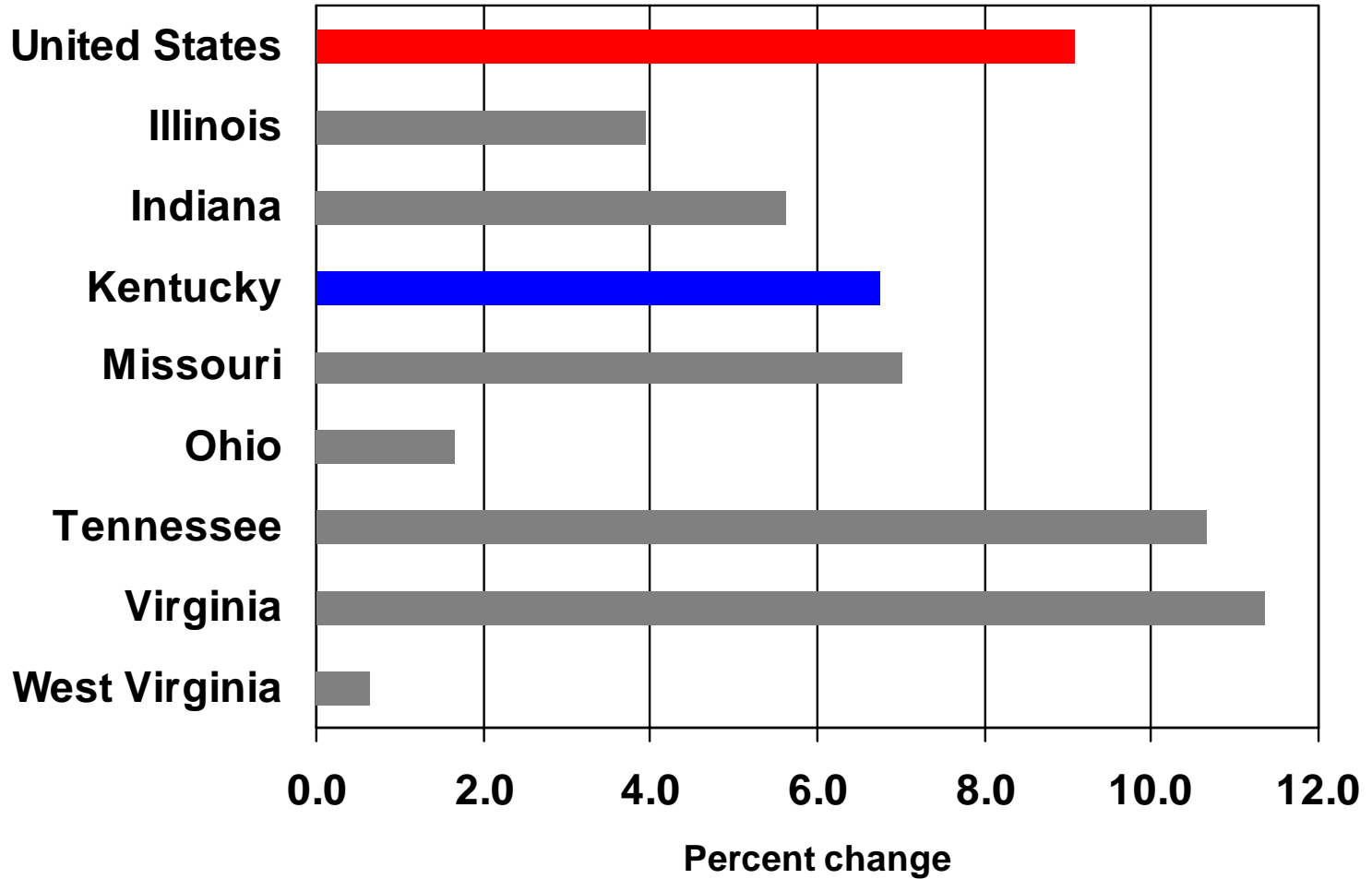




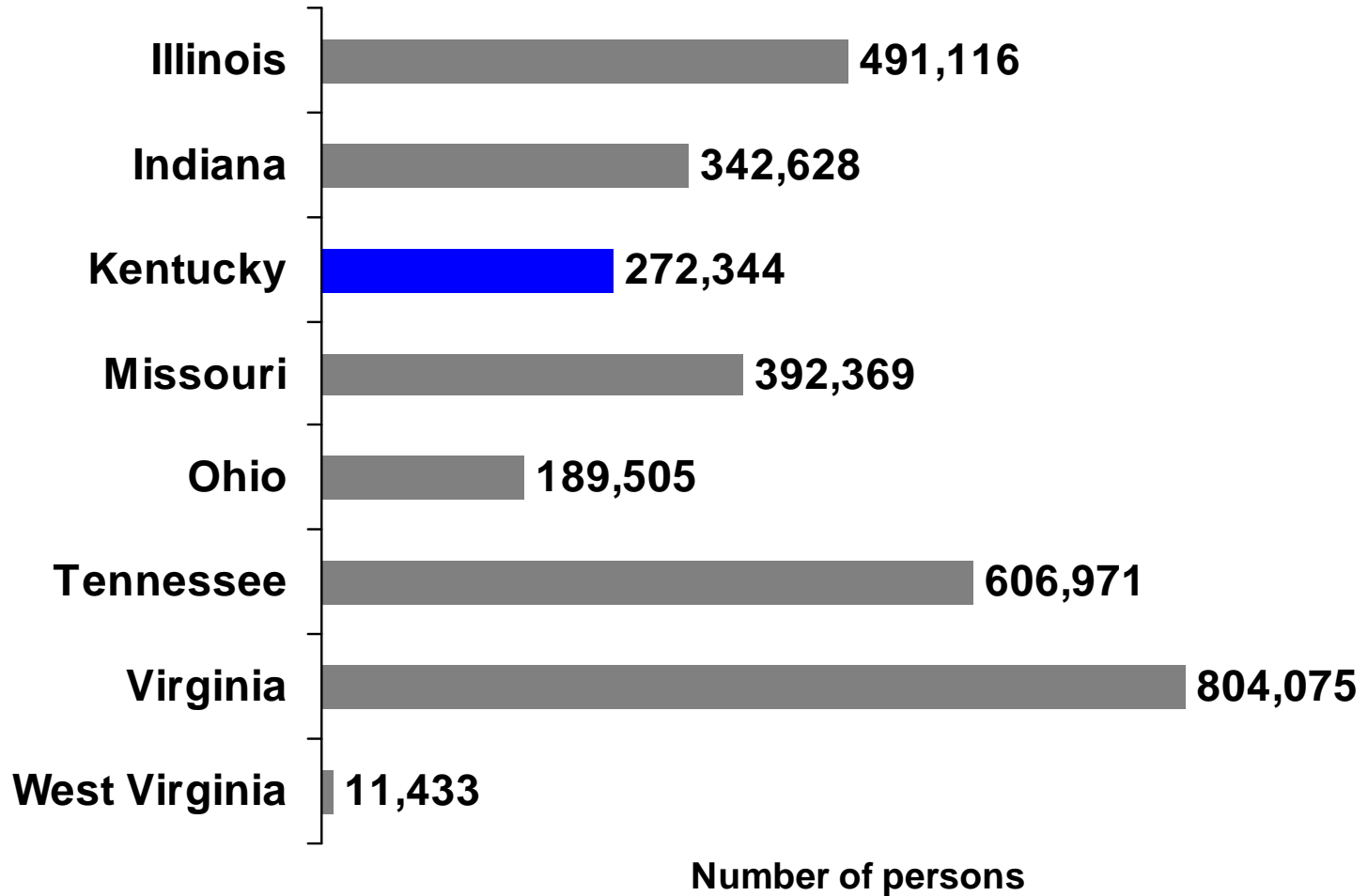

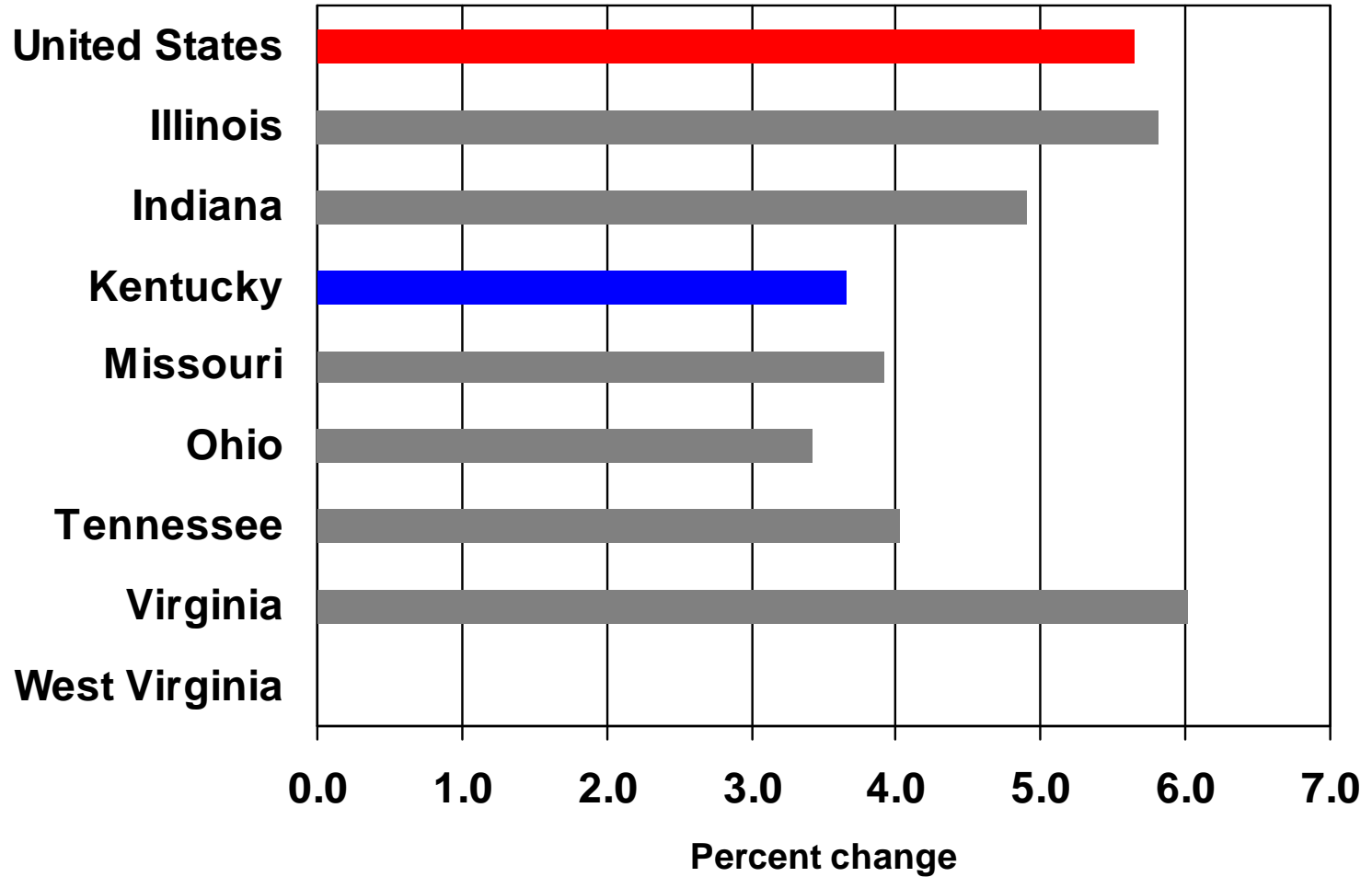
Population Growth Rates 2000-2009



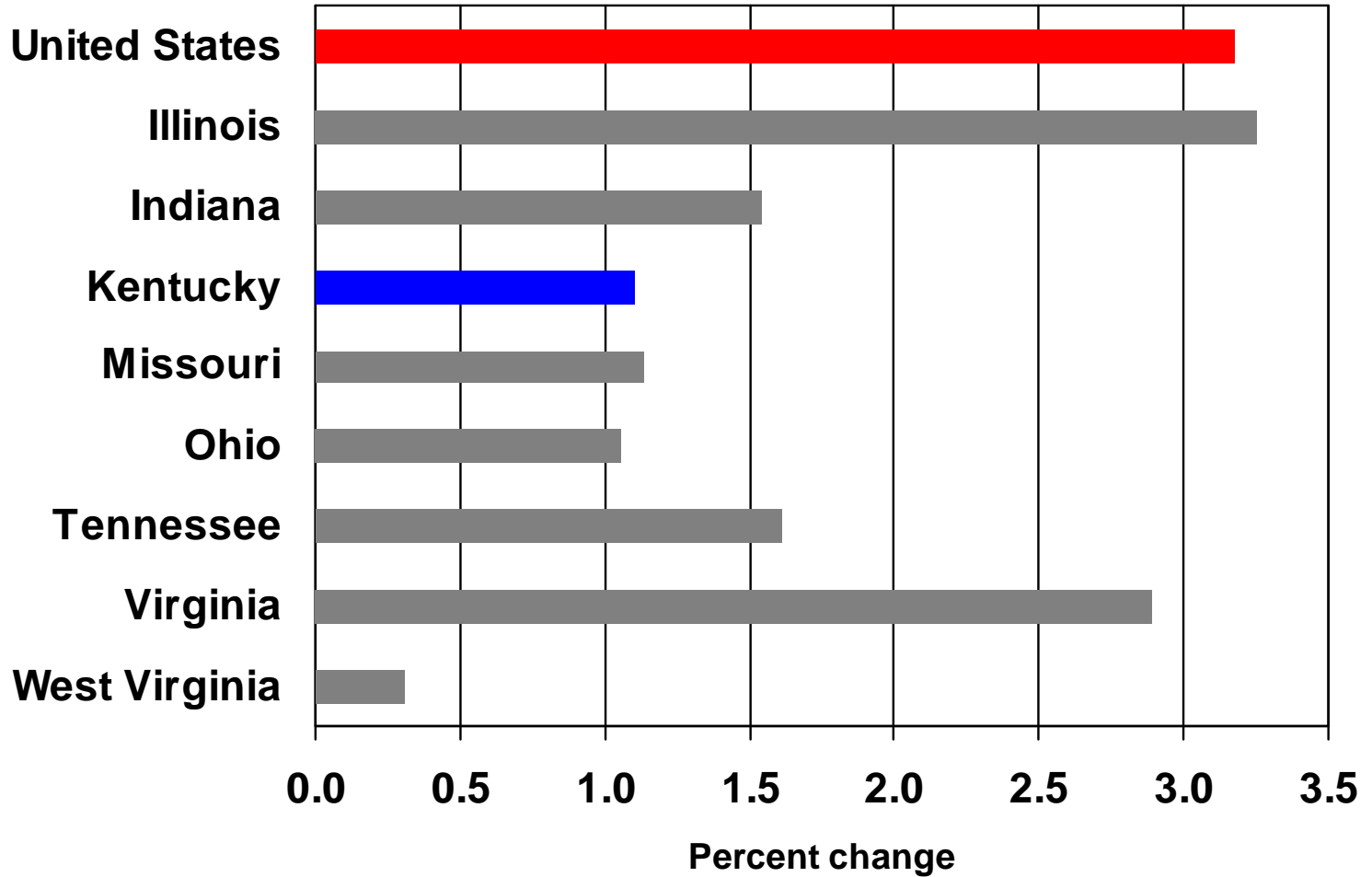
Population Growth 2000-2009



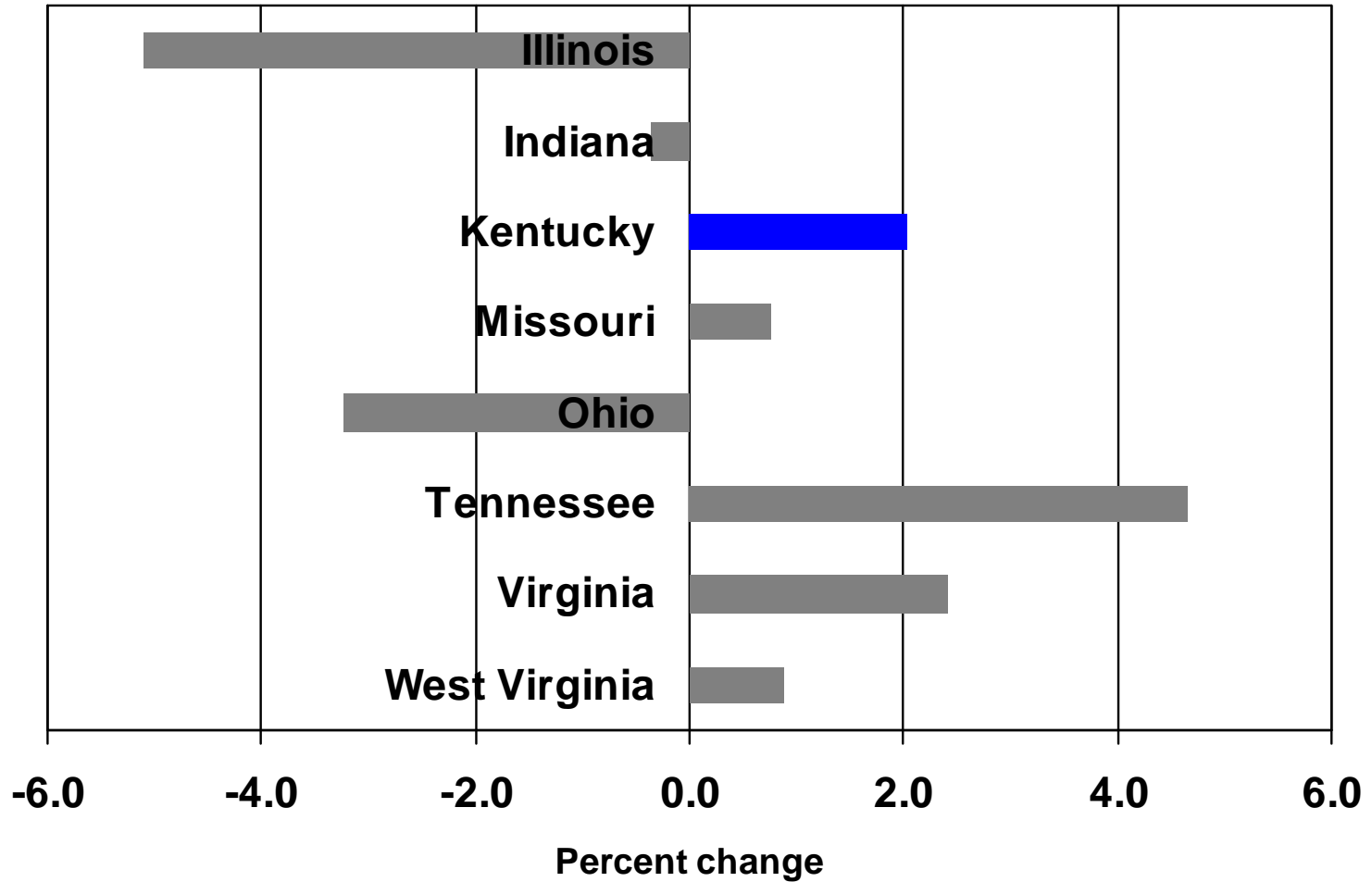
Natural Increase Rates 2000-2009



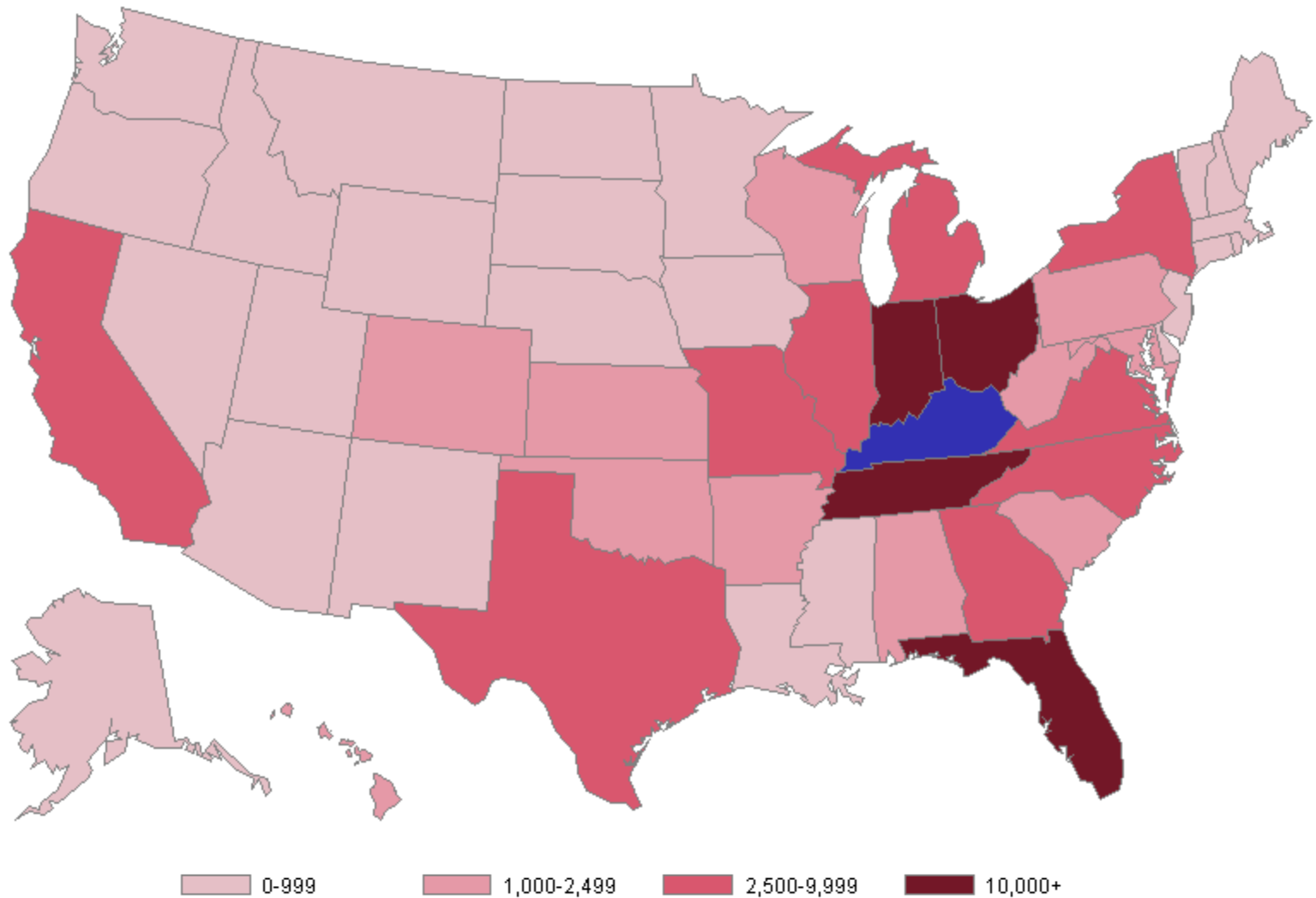
International Net Migration Rates 2000-2009



Domestic Net Migration Rates 2000-2009

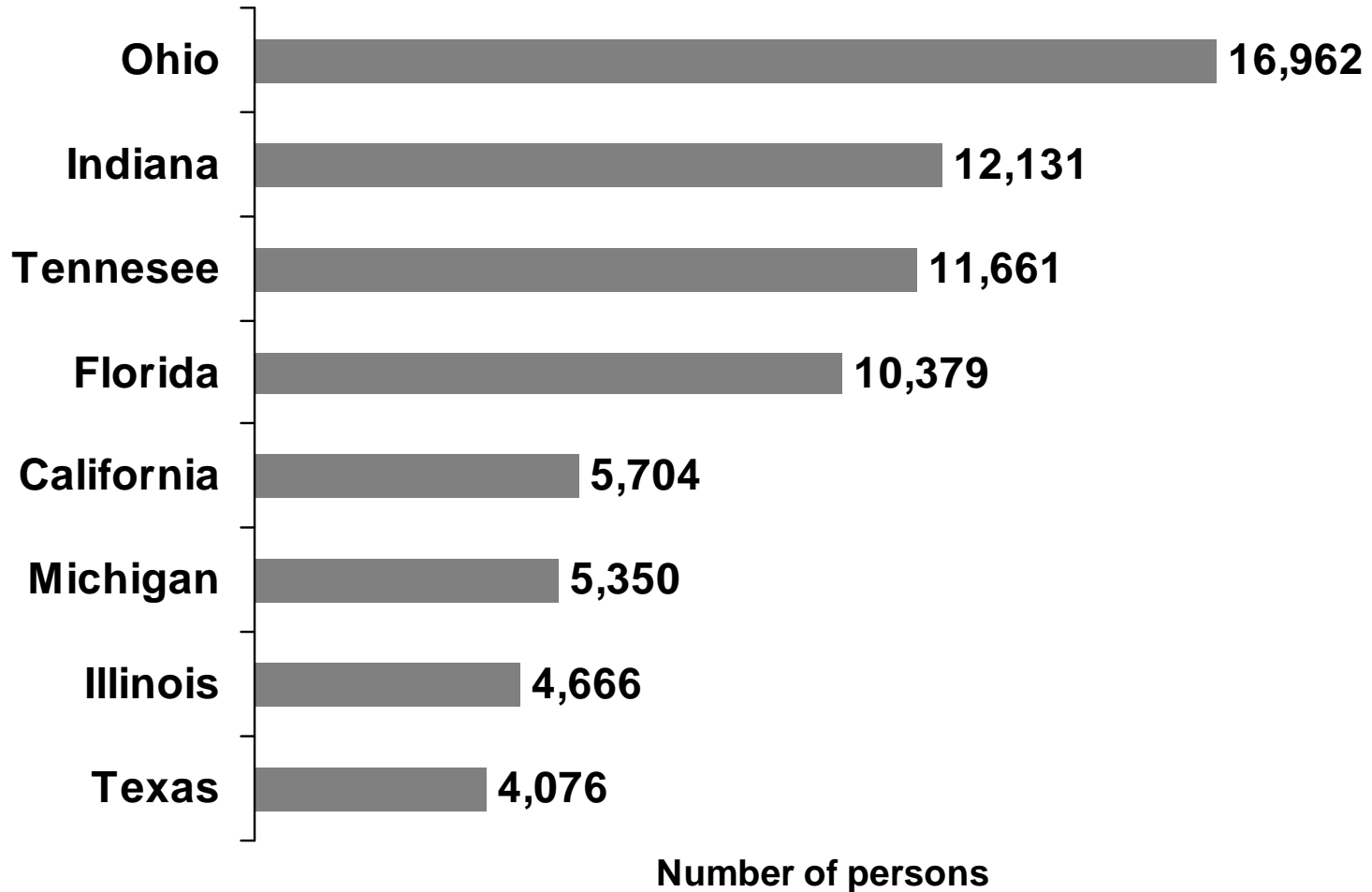


In-Migration* to Kentucky by State of Origin

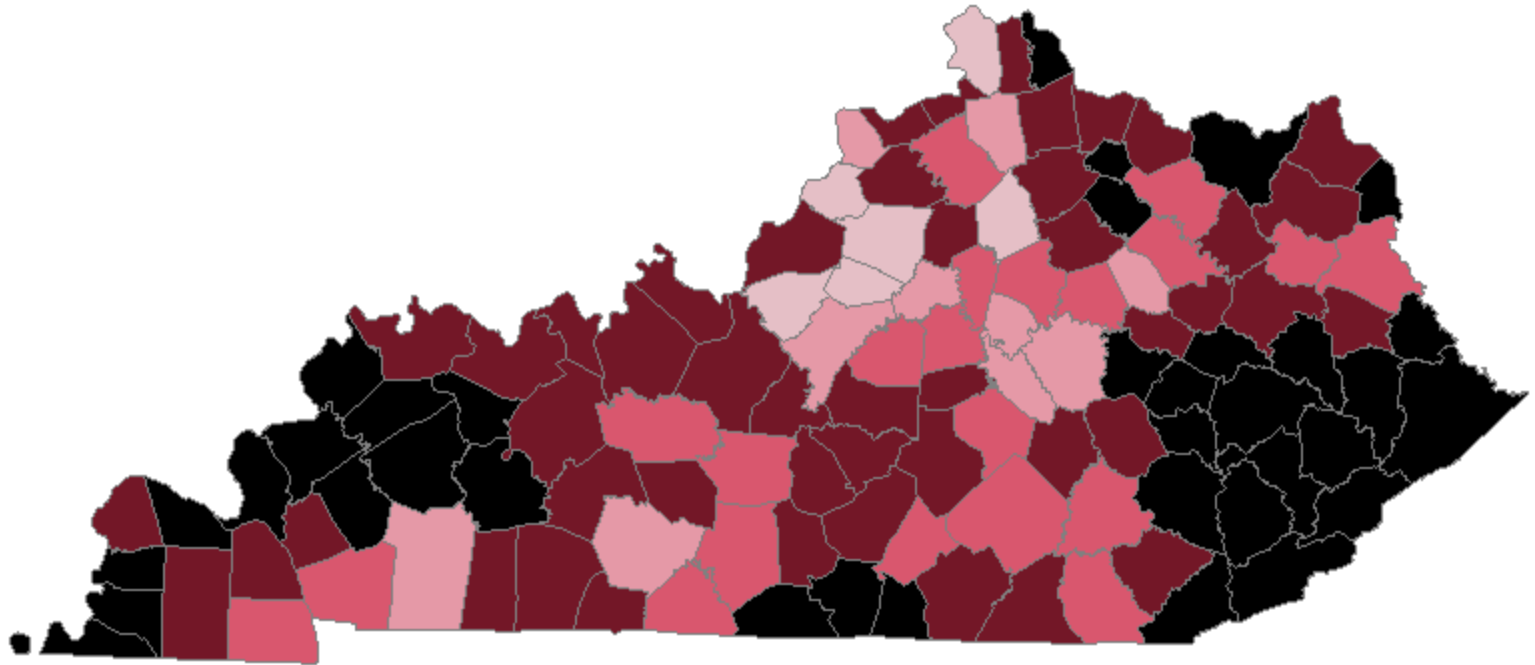

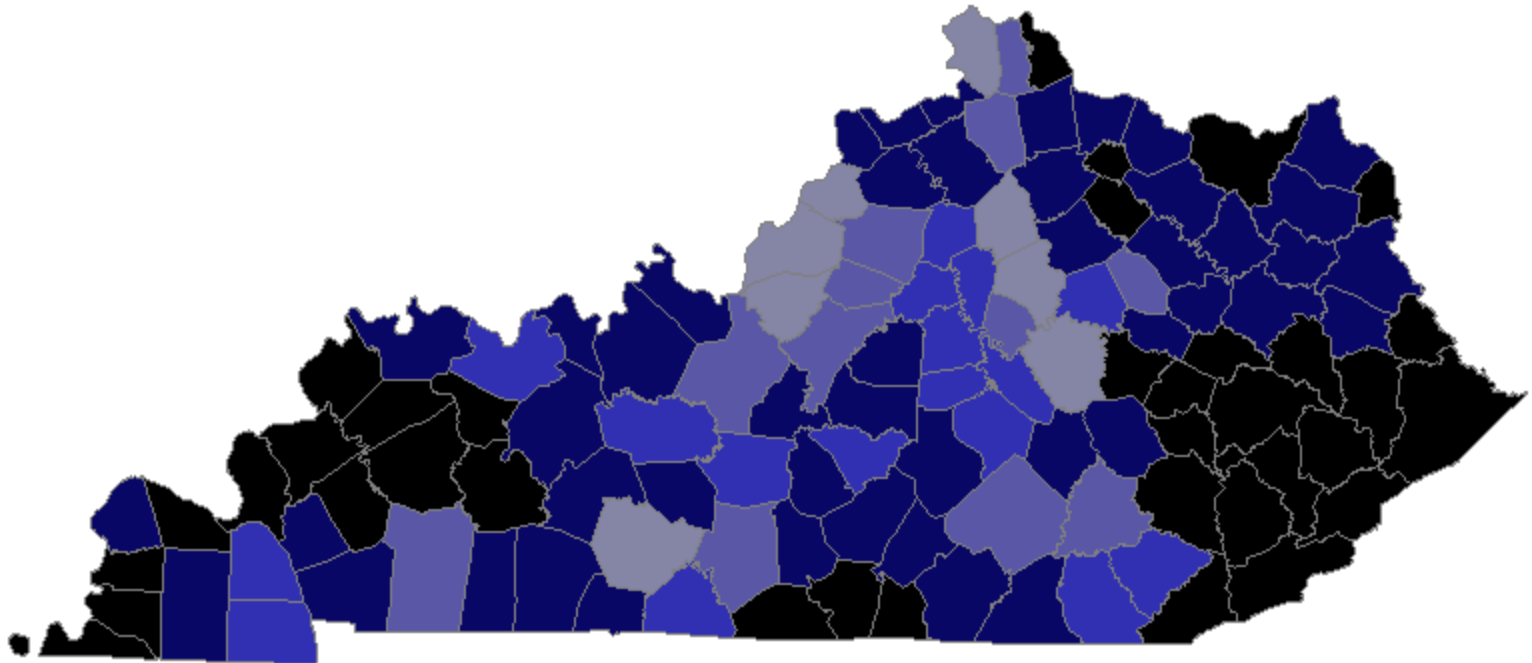

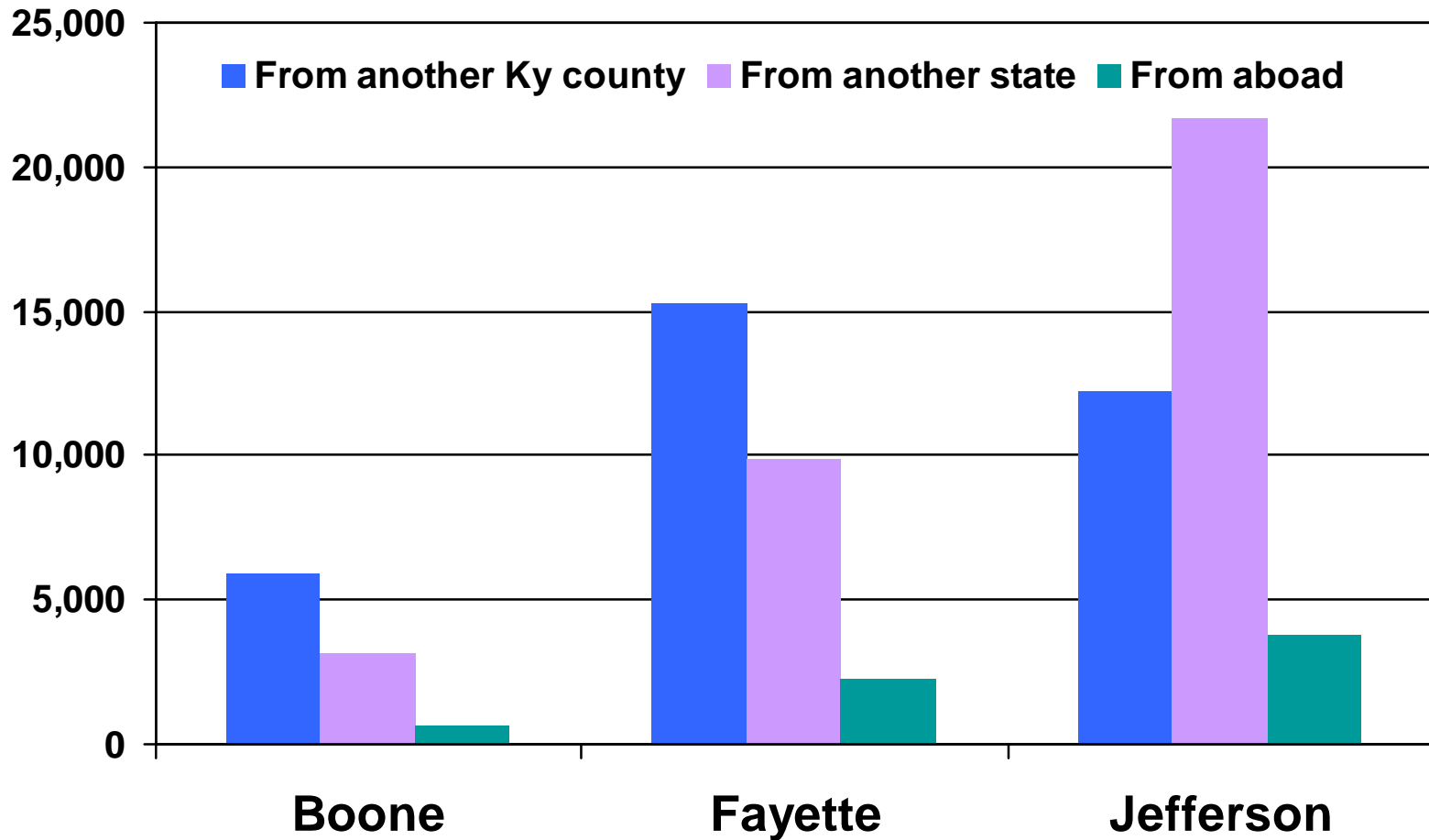
