generation turns 65 years old.**

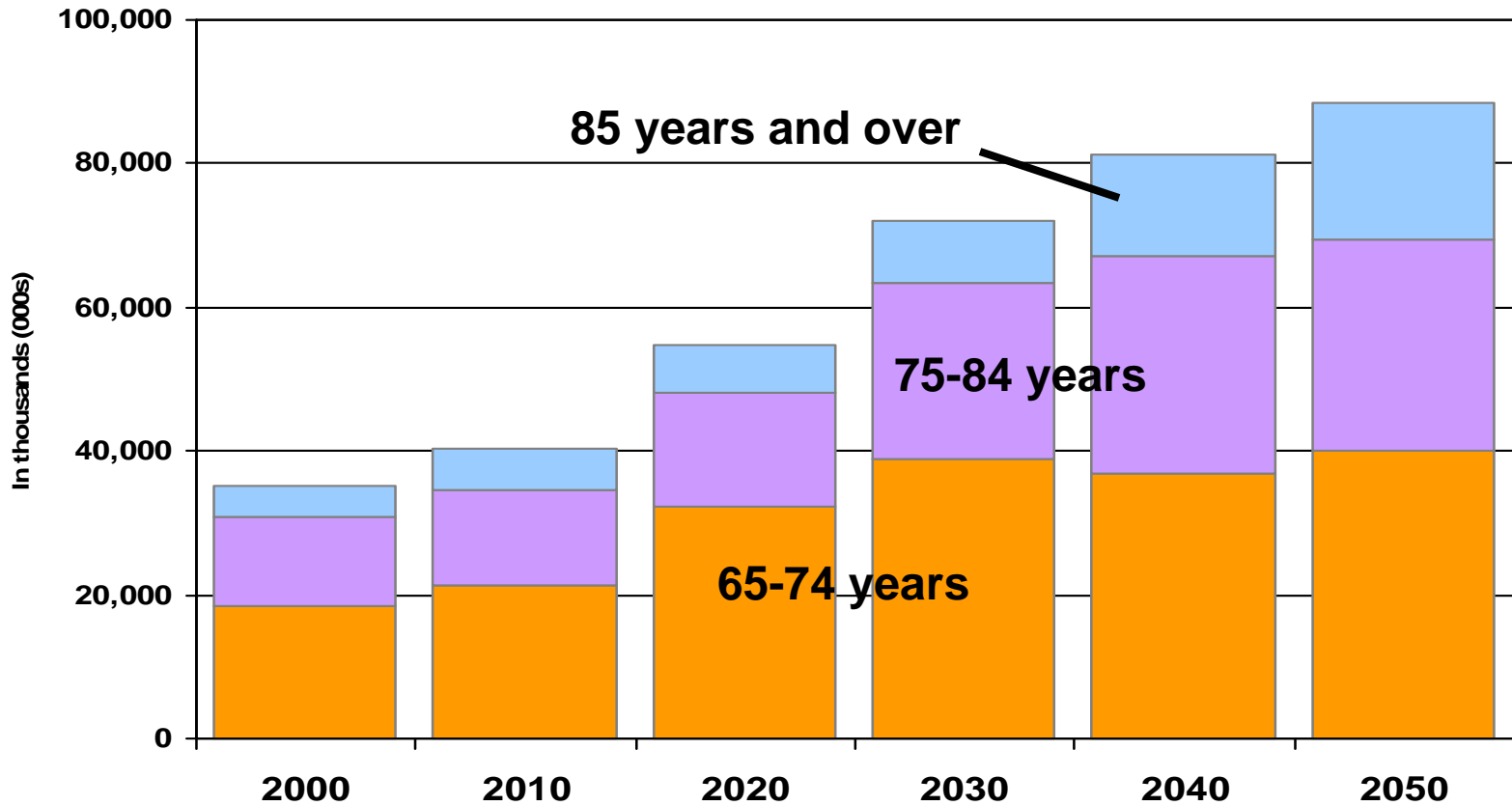
**U.S. population under age 30

310 million U.S. residents

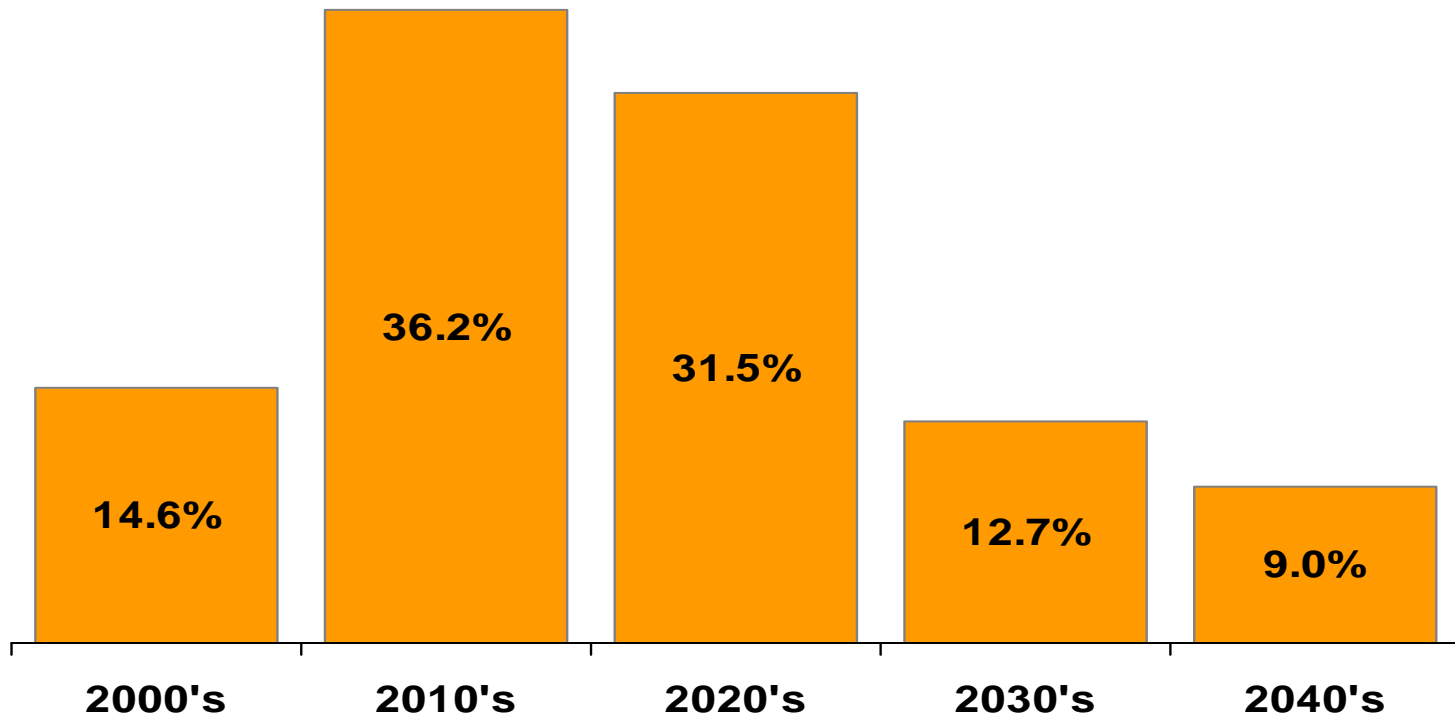
- 13% age 65 years and over**

U.S. Population Ages 65 Years and Over

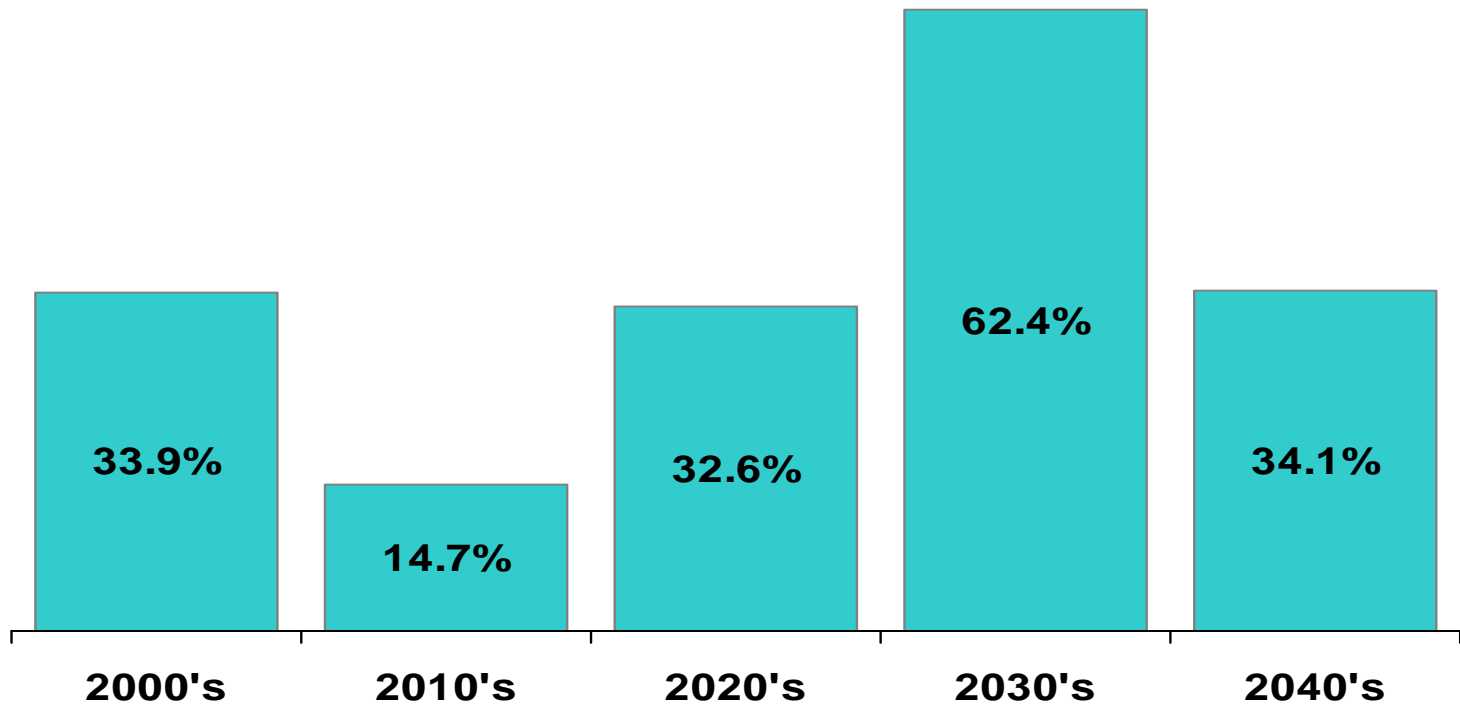

Growth Rates for Population Age 65 Years and Over



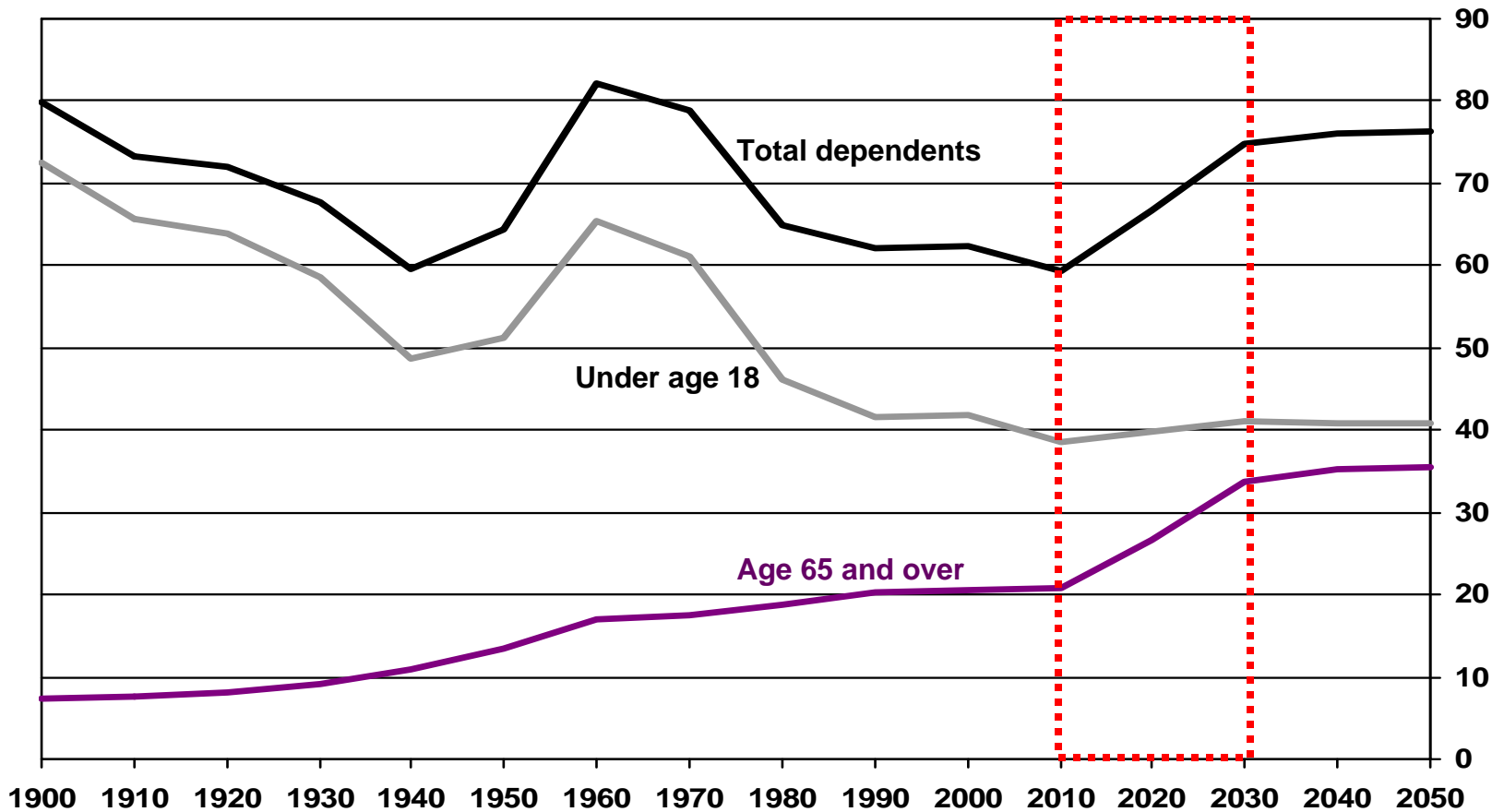
Growth Rates for Population Age 85 Years and Over



U.S. Age Dependency

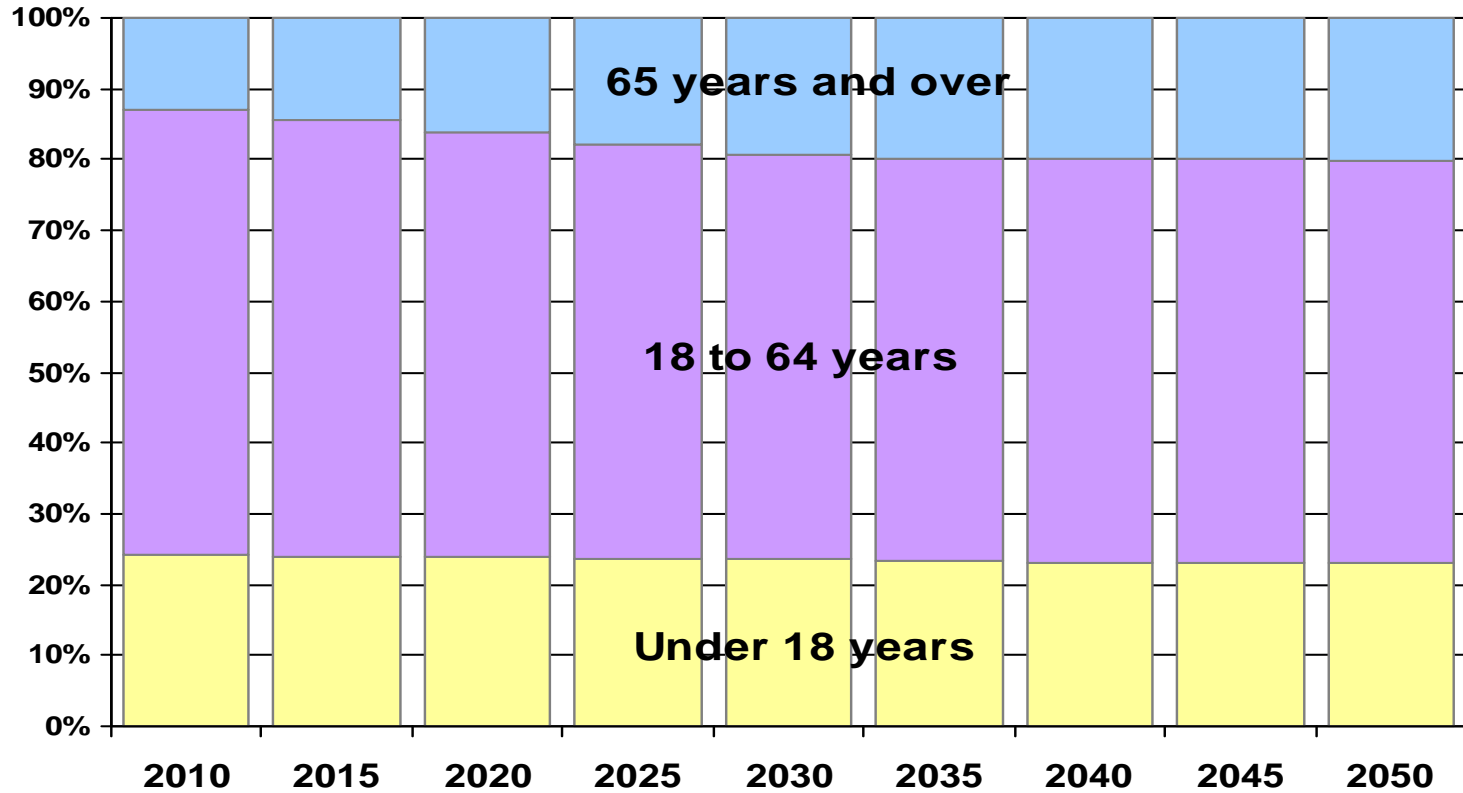
Number of dependents per 100 persons

Percent Distribution of U.S. Population by Age



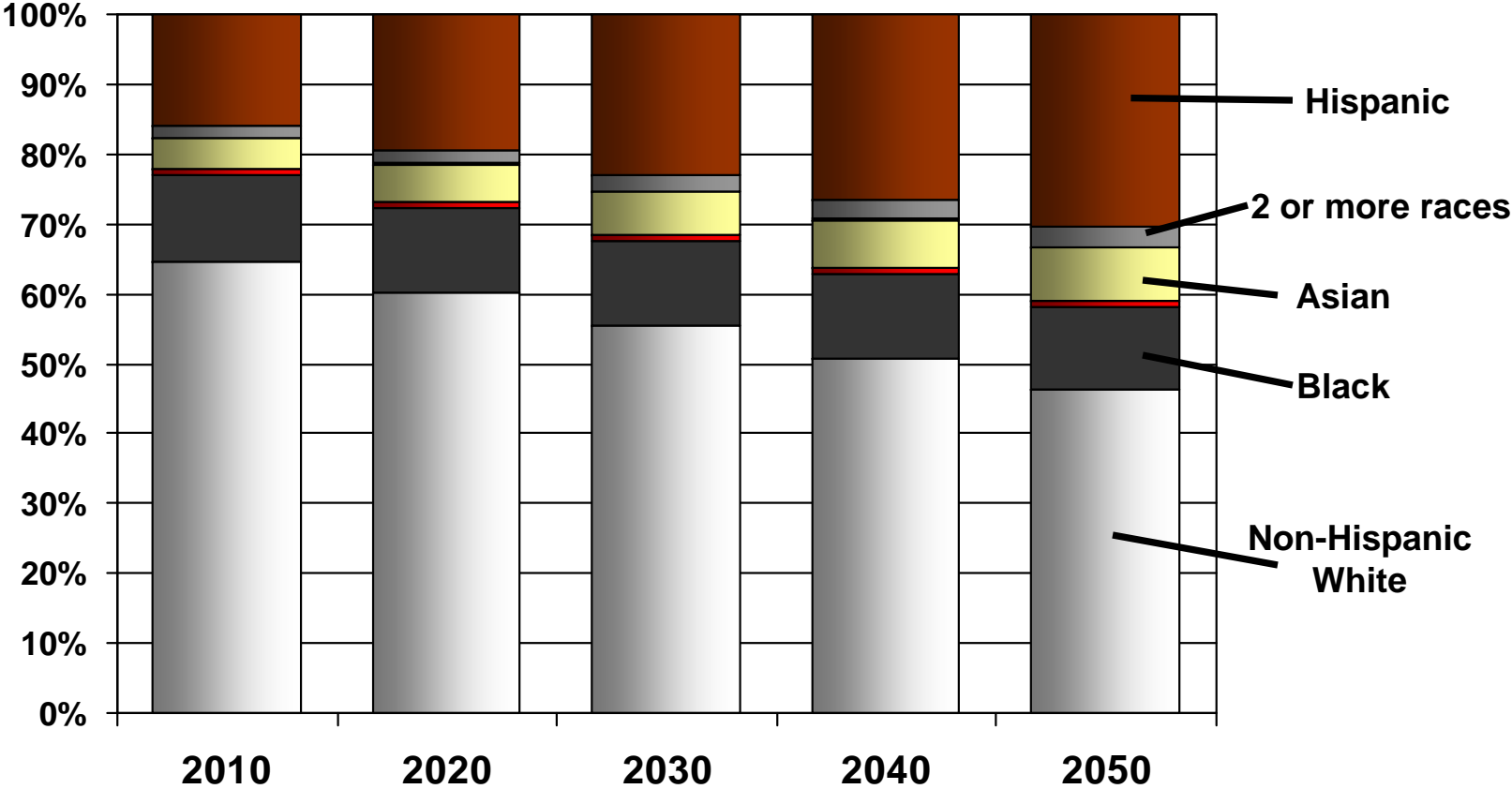

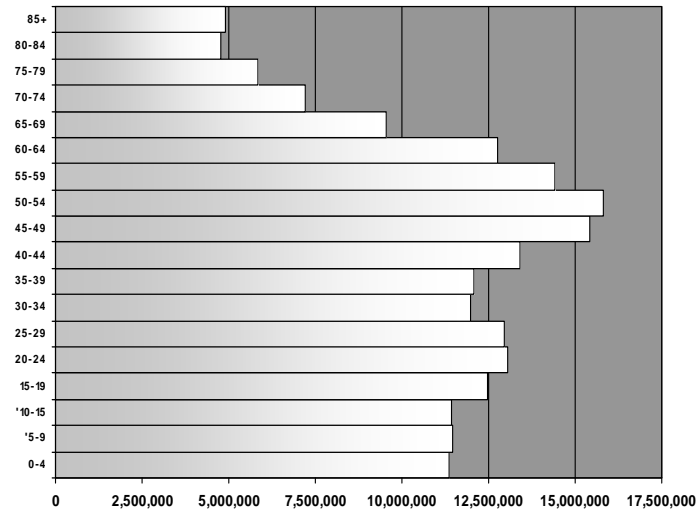

U.S. Population by Race and Ethnicity 2010-2050

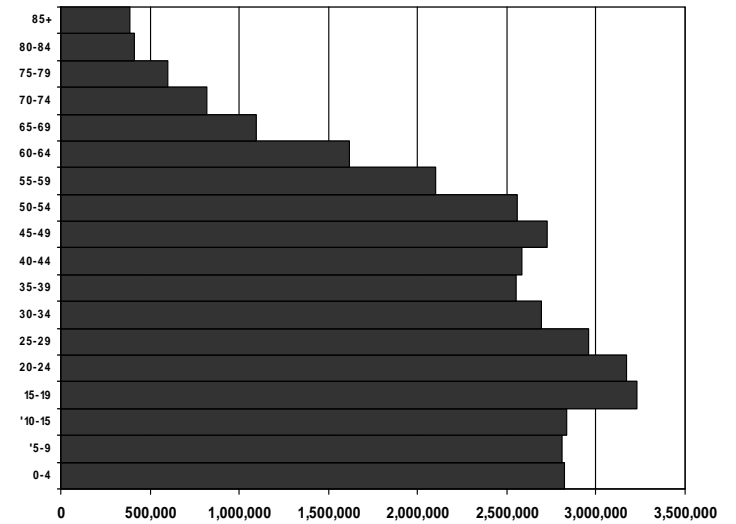


Race/Ethnic Populations by Age 2010

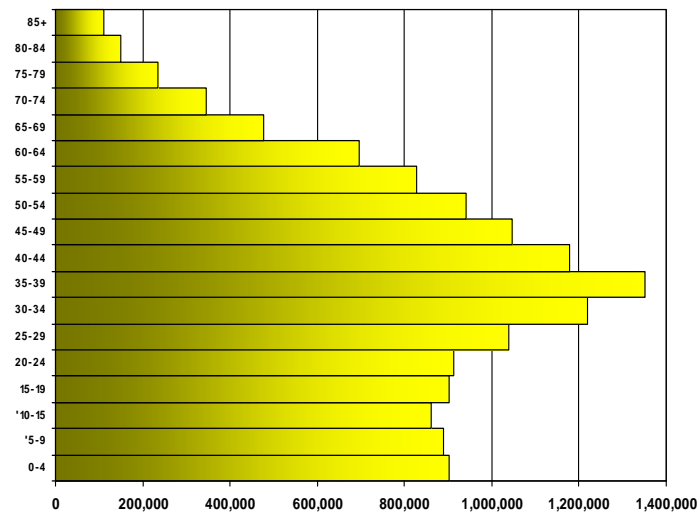

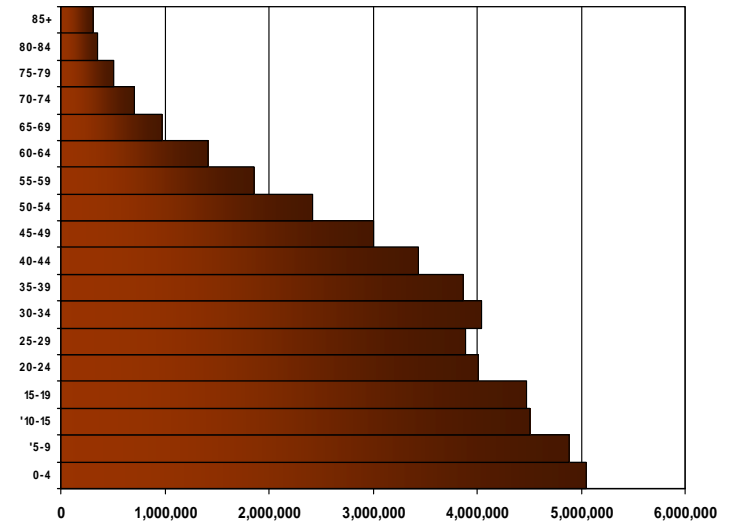

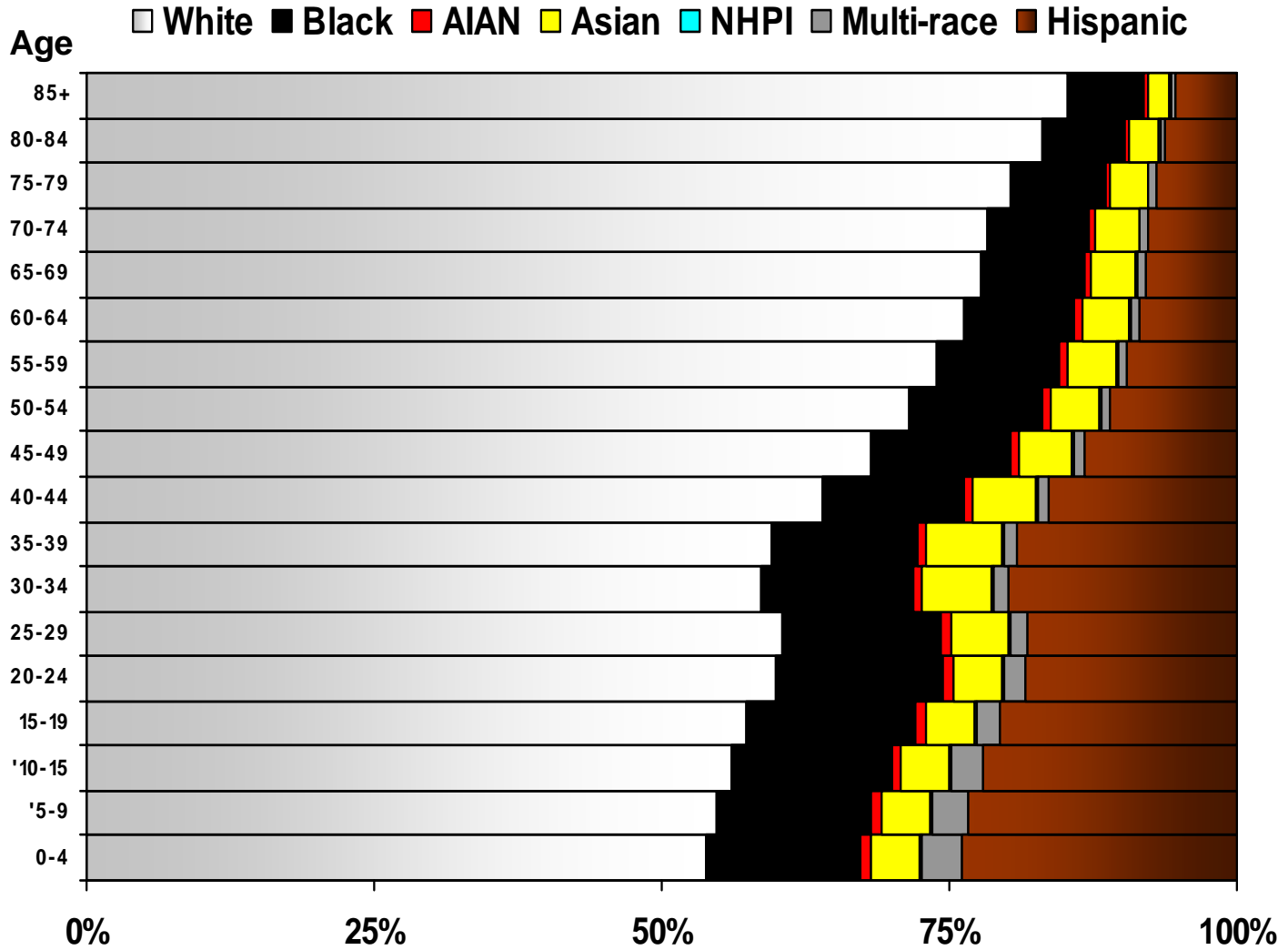

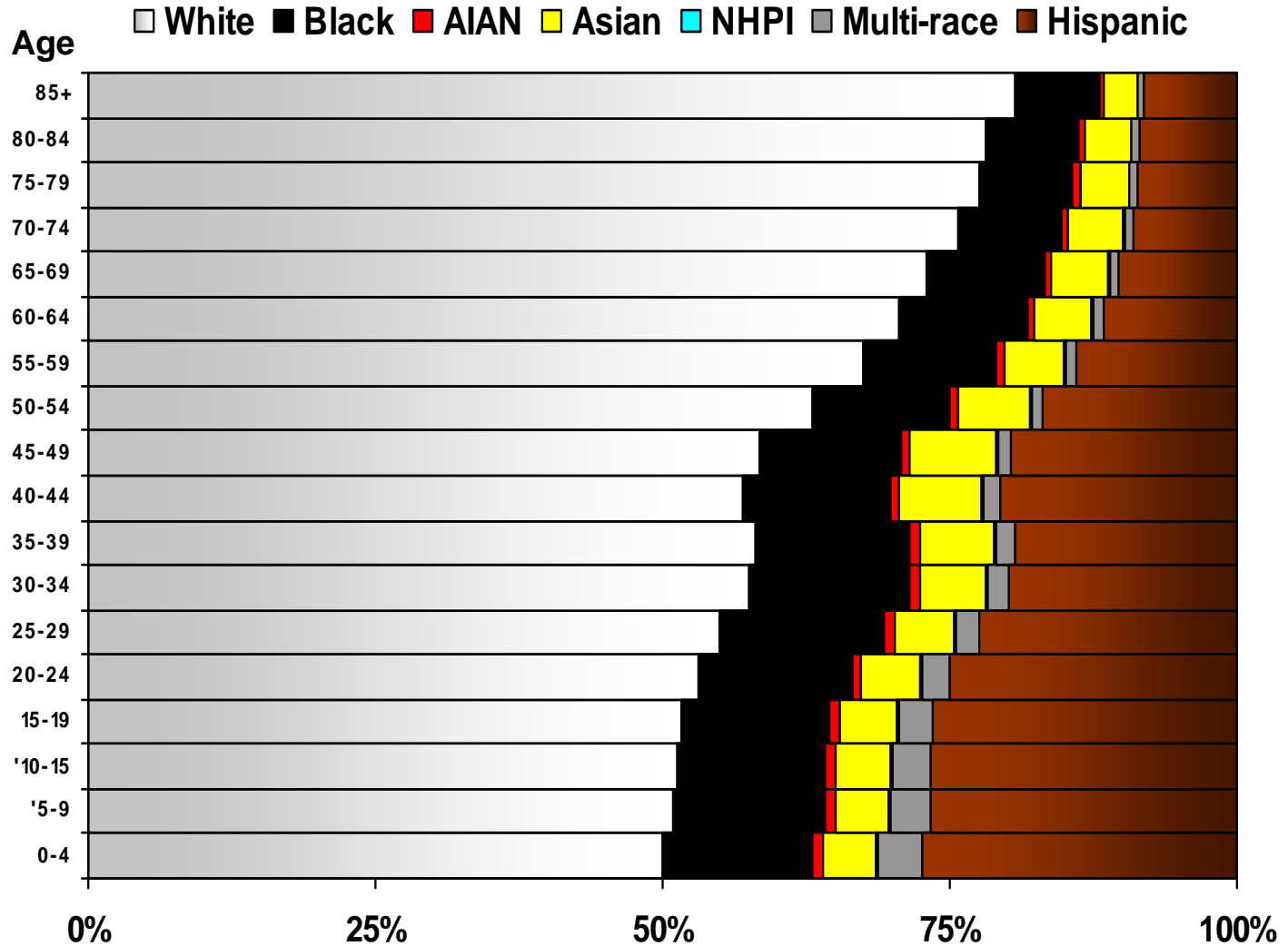

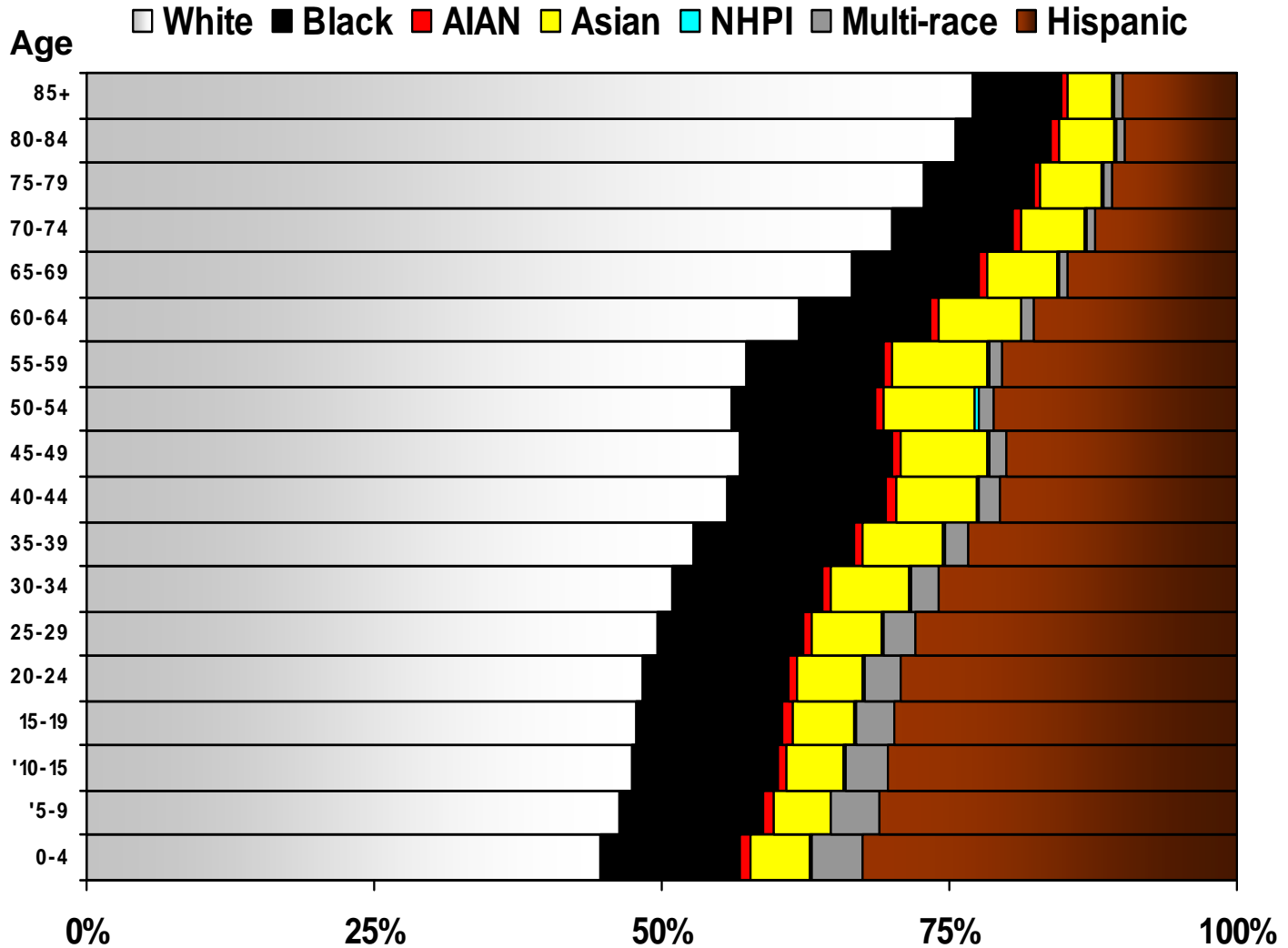

2020 U.S. Population: 40% Minorities



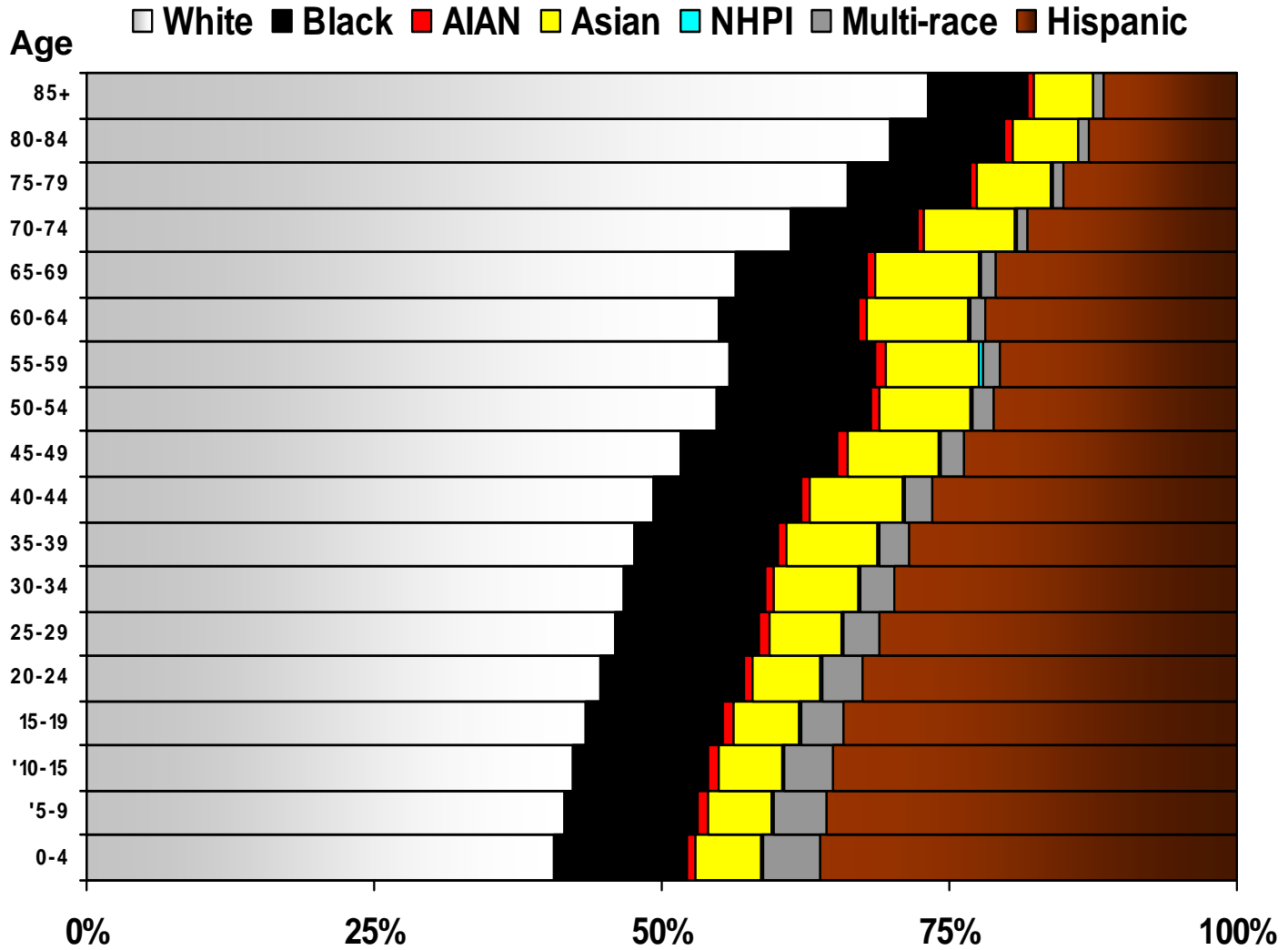

2030 U.S. Population: 45% Minorities



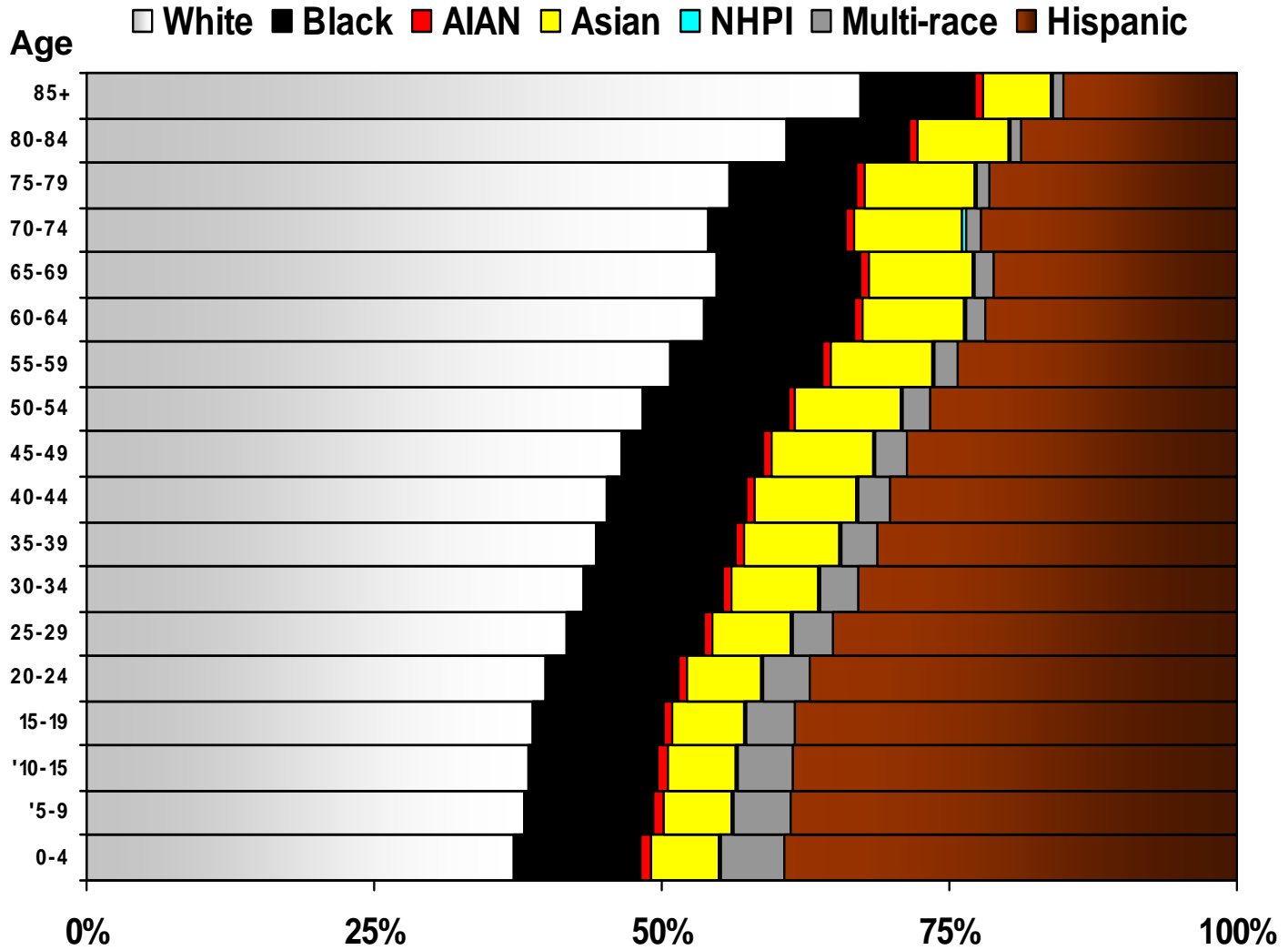

2040 U.S. Population: 49% Minorities



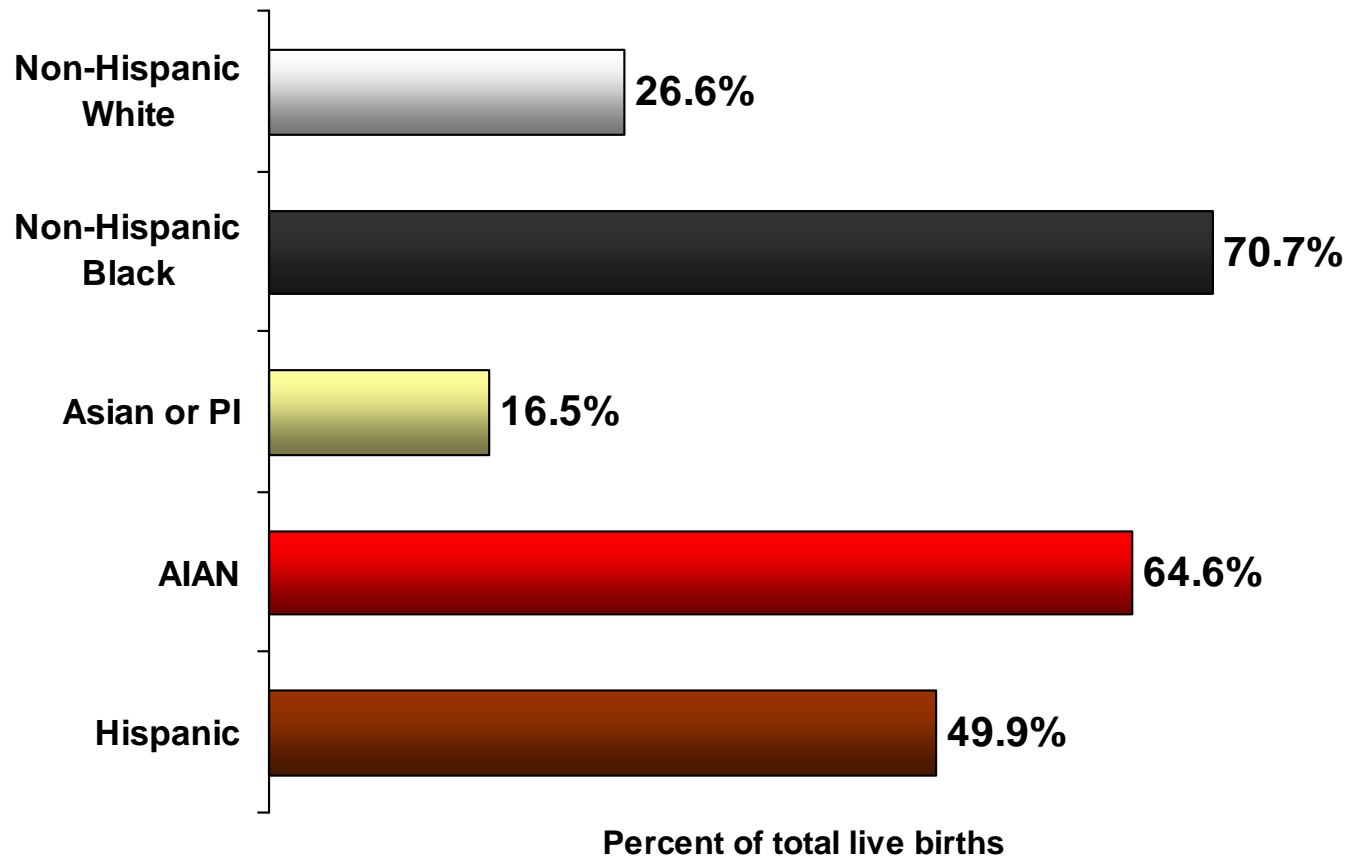

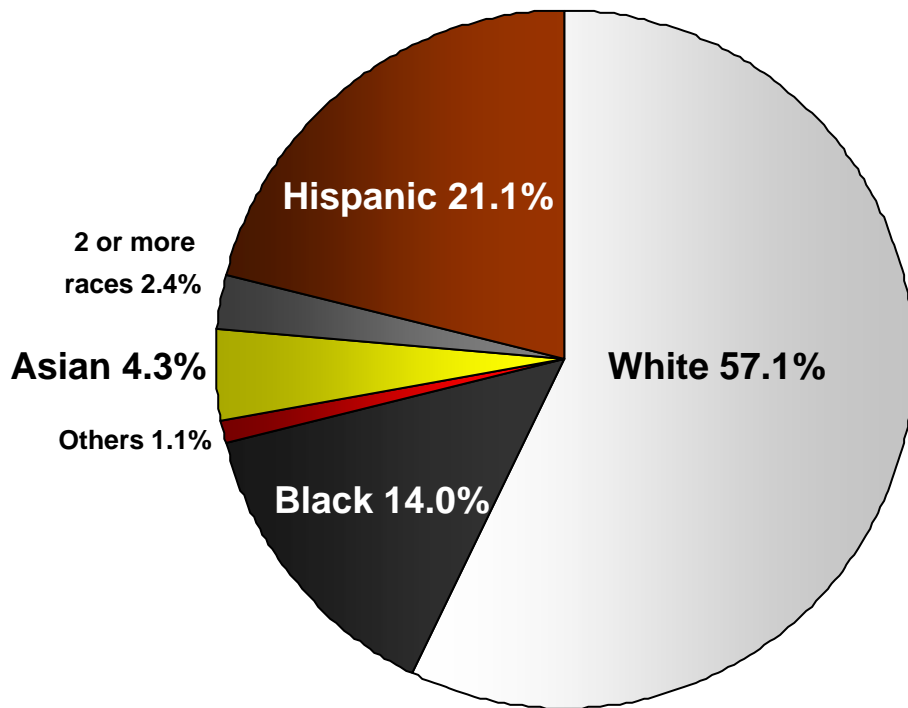
Births to Unmarried Mothers 2006



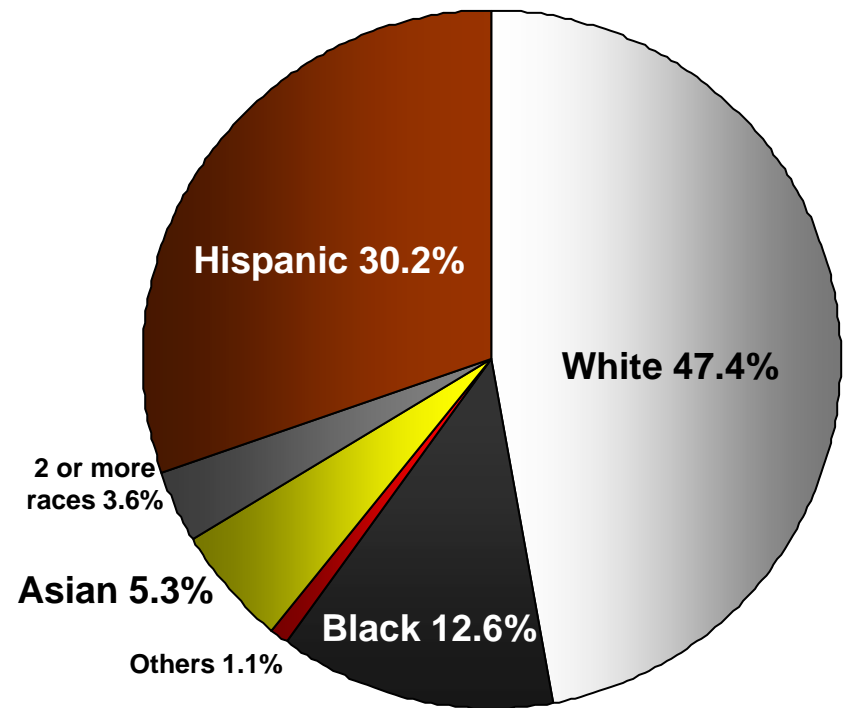

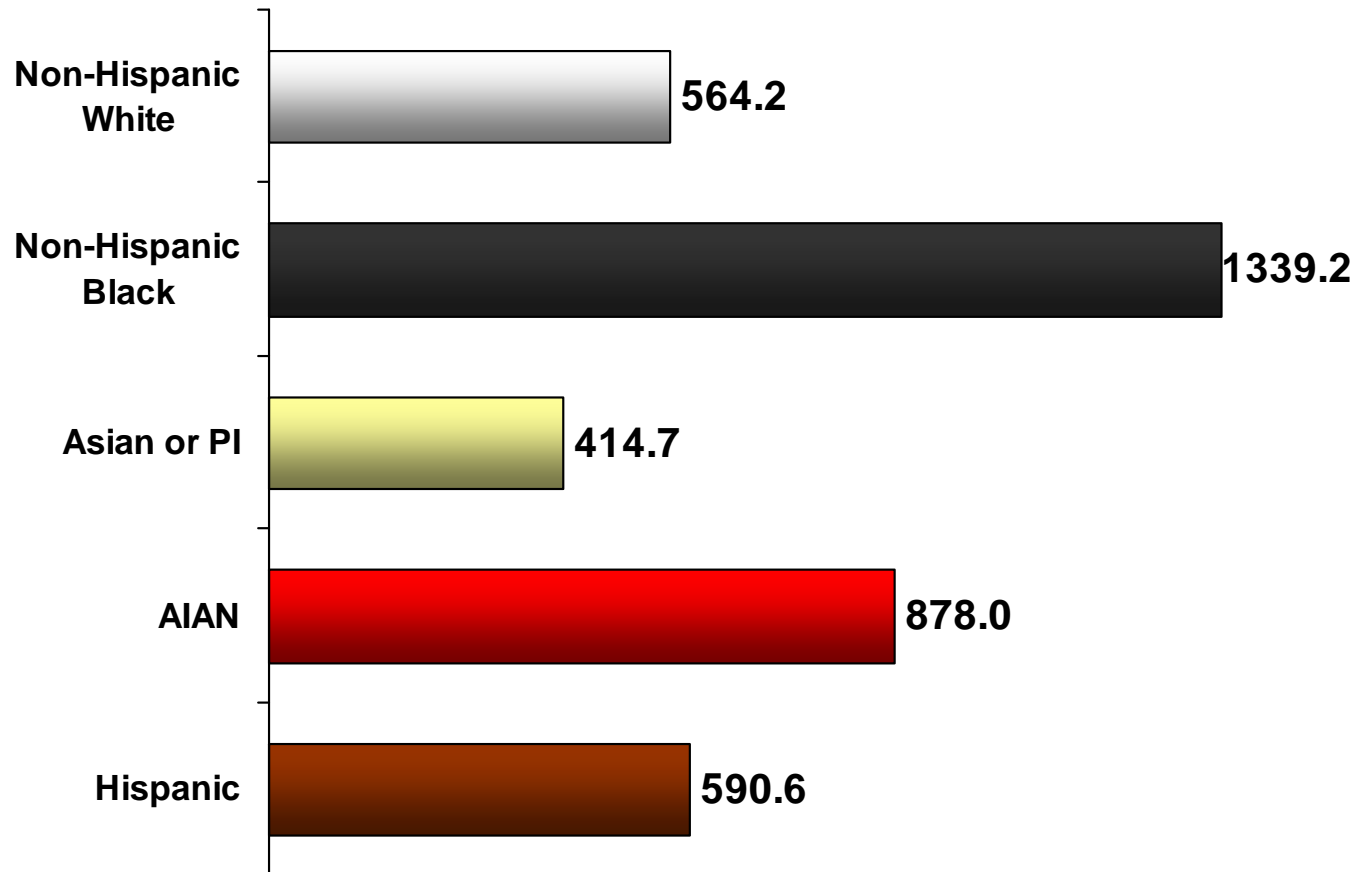
